Routine Gains Pubicit Some of his original routines have been published in Hugard's Magic Monthly and "The Phoenix," periodicals of the ledgerdemain brotherhood. He said the highest such honor was being included on the list of 115 magicians of America whose special tricks and brief biographies were compiled by James G. Thompson in a book entitled "My Best."
