### Illini Victory Dims '54 Rose Bowl Hopes

**Bolden Scores Three Times, Ground Attack Gains Heavily**

COLUMBUS—Michigan State didn't need a "transcontinental" here Saturday.

Sheer Spartan power ripped the Ohio State Buckeyes, 28-13, before a capacity throng of 82,328, fourth largest in Ohio Stadium history, in damp 35-degree weather.

Little Leroy Bolden scampered for three Michigan State touchdowns as he duplicated a similar performance at Minnesota only five weeks ago.

Bolden crossed the Buckeye goal line in the first, second and fourth periods on runs of 4, 37 and 20 yards, respectively. Despite Michigan State's impressive win, Spartan hopes for a Big 10 title and Rose Bowl trip in the first year of conference competition were dimmed as Illinois romped to their fourth straight Big 10 victory with a 19-3 conquest over Michigan.

But the Spartans gained undisputed second place and ruined any hopes that the Buckeyes may have had for a trip to Pasadena.

Statistically, the contest was fairly close, but Spartan ground attack told the story. Michigan State drove for 17 first downs compared to 14 for the Buckeyes, but piled up 305 yards on the ground while Ohio could manage only 199.

Both squads completed only four of 12 passes for little yardage despite the fact that each team scored a touchdown on an aerial play. MSC compiled 52 aerial yards, the Buckeyes 47.

For a while, it looked as if an extra point might decide the game as the Bucks pulled up to a 14-13 score with a third-quarter touchdown. But two Spartan tallies in the fourth quarter after a pair of fine defensive stands by the MSC line put the win into Green and White possession.

Although the contest was close, the Spartans were not forced to come from behind as in 1951, when the famous Yewick to Al Dorow transcontinental play claimed MSC's comeback from a 20-10 deficit and facilitated a thrilling 26-20 victory.

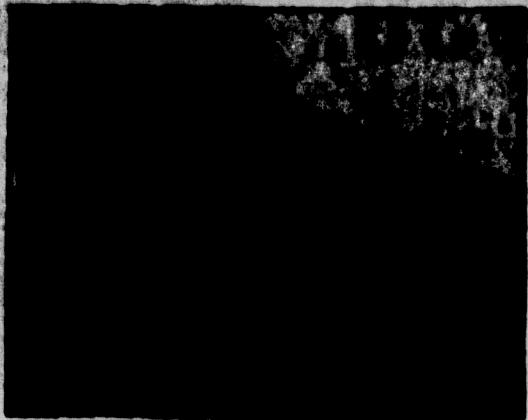

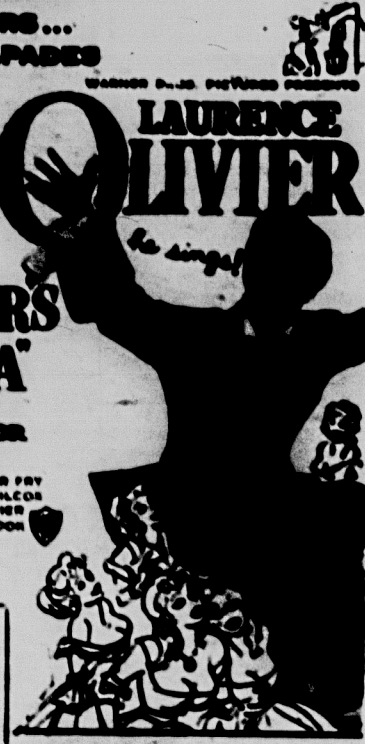

### Caroline Sets New Record

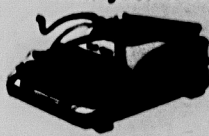
CHAMPAIGN, Ill. (AP)—Sophomore halfback J. C. Caroline broke a record set by Red Grange 30 years ago as unbeaten Illinois made Michigan its fourth straight Big 10 victim, 19 to 3.

Caroline rushed 184 yards in 30 carries and picked up 75 more yards on punt and kickoff returns and a pass reception. The performance boosted his total yardage gained in all departments to 1,334 in seven games. As a sophomore in 1923, the immortal Grange set an unofficial conference mark of 1,200 yards.
