## Fall Enrollment Reaches Highest Figure in History

## But Budget Cuts Down Fall Flood Enrollment this fall will reach a total of 25,044, the highest foigure in the univers- ity's history, Registrar Kermit Smith announced Thursday at Smith announced Thursday at the close of the regular regis- tration period. tration period. This figure above last year's comparable total of 23,373 . However the East Lansing campus errollment was only 22,637 This is 77 more than the 22,500 students to which the 22,500 students to which the Board of Trustees directed the enrollm years legnislative cut ed appropriations. More than 24,600 students had been planned for when the request for request for appropriations was summitted to the state legis- lature. The budget limitations most heavily affected the number of new students admitted. in keeping wihh last May's trustee directive, the number of new keerective, the number of new dreshman enrolled totalled 4 ,- fesman 740, only 1 per c last year's fres ment of 4,690 . As a result of this restriction, many qualified freshmen had
