## Cancer Theory Cuts Down Ads

| carrying as many tobacco advertisements as they used to. <br> In most cases the papers are willing to carry the ads, but the tobacco companies themselves have cut down on this form of ad- vertising. <br> The reason, said Dr. James S. Feurig, director of Olin Health Center, is the alleged connection between smoking and lung cancer. <br> Feurig said the AmericanCollege Health Association recommended that tobacco advertising down, but the tobacco companies withdrew their ads without being pressured. <br> The companies have also cut down on the use of athletes' endorsements in advertising. <br> Feurig said he thinks the action on the part of the thaties is an admission that there is a connection between smoking and lung cancer. <br> Experimentation has shown that tobacco contains tars which could cause cancer, Feurig said. At first the tobacco companies refused to accept the findings because the experiments were "too much animal and not enough hu- |

He suggested fiveyears ould be significant. <br> "Smokers who are in poor alth find it easier to give up the bit than those who are well,' eurig said. |
