## "A STORY OF VIOLENT JEALOUSY"

Mary MacDowall, the quiet watercress girl, violently attacks another woman in the MASTER-PIECE THEATRE series COUNTRY MATTERS episode "The Watercress Girl" Wednesday at 8:30 p.m. on Channel 10.

The story of tangled love and hate is told in flashbacks in the Mobil-funded drama produced by England's Granada Television and presented on the Public Broadcasting Service.

"The Watercress Girl" opens as Mary MacDowall (Susan Fleetwood) is apprehended by the police as she is working in the watercress bed of her father's small farm. She is accused of throwing acid in the face of Elizabeth Plantney (Susan Tebbs).

In court, Frank Oppidan (Gareth Thomas) explains that he had courted Mary and been refused. He says he then begins to see Elizabeth and the tow of them made plans to marry. He testifies that one night when he and Elizabeth were out walking, Mary followed them and threw acid at Elizabeth, disfiguring her.

Mary is convicted of the assault and sentenced to two years in prison. After serving her term, she prepares to leave the prison, unaware that Frank is waiting for her - with a bottle of acid.

Frank intends to be revenged upon Mary for what she did to Elizabeth. He goes to her house, only to find that the old attraction takes over. Mary, in turn, gives Frank the answer to questions he has been asking himself for two years. Did she really mean to assault Elizabeth? Did she ever love him?
