



A LIAISON DOG—This dog of war, like many of his kind, is trained to carry messages from one officer to another through a rain of machine gun fire that makes all other means of communication impossible. The photograph shows a liaison dog, with a message attached to his collar, bounding off on one of his missions from the trenches. Many of these dogs are killed in the work and frequently they arrive at their destination exhausted by wounds only to die a few moments after their faithful missions are executed.
