COMPATRIOTS OF VICTIMS ACT

Polish and Bohemian Leaders Plan Relief to the Survivors.

International and national organizations of Polish and Bohemian speaking people and prominent business men and leaders among these peoples immediately when the scope of the Eastland disaster was known took steps to take a hand in giving relief and aid to the stricken survivors of the victims, to aid in burying the dead, to demand redress for the sacrificed lives, and to unite in seeing that criminal prosecutions be instituted against public officials and the steamship people who can in any way be connected with the disaster.

Three meetings of officials and leaders of three principal organizations of Polish speaking people were called and will take place this afternoon.
