



SCENES OF THE RUSSIAN RETREAT—The idea of freedom after the revolution was too great for the Russian soldiers to comprehend. Abandoning their arms, they fled in wild and disordered retreat, creating some of the most shameful scenes in history. In the top picture a typical instance was snapped, showing soldiers scurrying to cover upon hearing that the German cavalry had broken through the lines. The center and lower pictures show respectively a retreat unconduted, and an orderly retreat under the protection of British artillery.
