Symphony Will End Season with Flourish

Final Weeks See Brilliant Splurge of Bach, Brahms, Native Music.

WORD of the final six weeks of the Chicago Symphony orchestra season indicates that the great organization plans to end its series with all banners flying. It is the same sort of flourish that occurred during the month of January, although rather more so.

The concerts of March 21-22, for example, are to add to the Bach anniversary year. Glenn Dillard Gunn, Vitaly Schnee, and Henry Weber are to play the concerto for three pianos, and Mischa Mischakoff and John Weicher the concerto for

two violins. On the following week Vladimir Horowitz, who incidentally, is giving a piano recital at Orchestra hall this afternoon, will play Rachmaninoff's Third Concerto, the work with which he rather upset previous standards of measurement in his first appearance several years ago.

Winning Composition in Swift Contest to Be Played.

For April 4 and 5 Conductor Frederick Stock sends word of an all American program. One of the numbers will be "A Year's Chronicle," by Norman Lockwood, the \$1,000 prize winning composition in the Gustavus F. Swift competition proposed last summer. Louis Gruenberg's "Serenade" and a composition by David Van Vactor will also be on the list. One week later Oseip Gabrilowitsch will appear as piano soloist, playing both the Brahms concertos, an event that ought to give all good Brahmins something to think about.

The semi-final program will again turn to Bach, presenting "The Passion According to St. Matthew." Here Mr. Stock and the orchestra will need and receive much assistance, 335 singing voices, according

to announcement. The Apollo Musical club, whose director is Edgar Nelson, will be one aiding body, the Chicago Symphony choir, directed by Walter Aschenbrenner, another, and the soloists will be such notables as Claire Dux, soprano; Kathryn Meisle, contralto; Frederick Jagel, tenor; Chase Baromeo, baritone, and Fred Patton, basso.

Votes for Request Program Should Be In by April 5.

The last program will be one of requests, the only one of that character given this season. As it will take not less than three weeks to count the votes and prepare the program, the management makes its own request to the effect that all communications bearing on the subject be submitted not later than April 5.

As another item in commemoration of the Bach anniversary, Max Bendix has transcribed the third sonata in E, originally written for piano and violin, into the form of a string quartet. It will be played by the Josefier String quartet on the program at the Cordon club tonight.

Mava Eggerth's First Film to Be "April in Paris"

MAVA EGGERTH, Hungarian beauty and opera singer, has the rare opportunity of knowing what her first Hollywood picture is to be. The first vehicle on which she is to work, under her contract with Universal, is "April in Paris." B. Y. Harburg, author of a song by that title, sold the studio the idea of a story based on it, which he is writing in association with Franz Schulz, author of the German play, "Two Hearts in Waltz Time."
