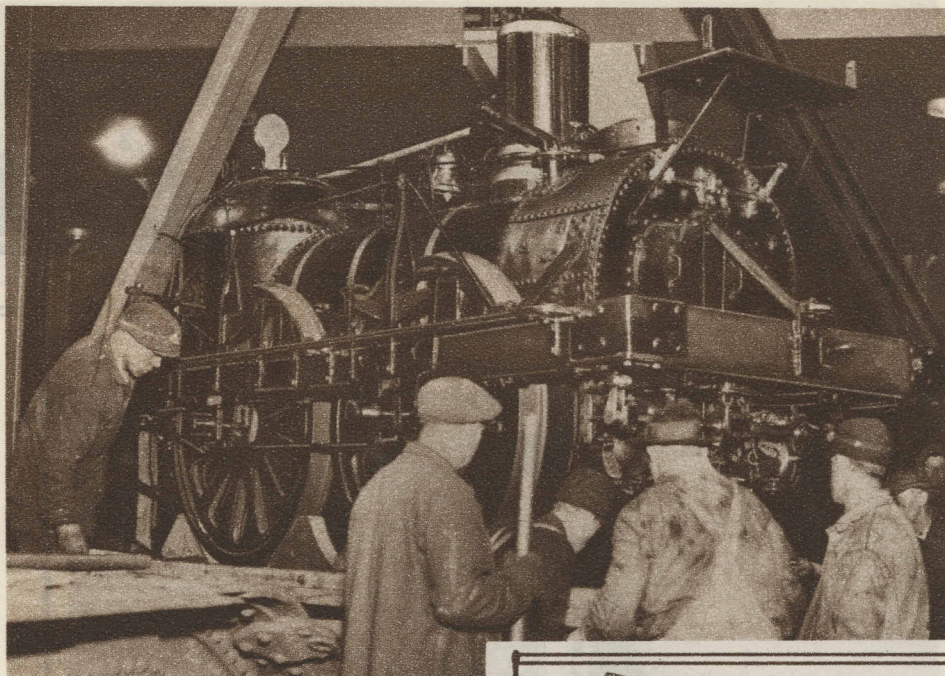


THE MINNETONKA, an engine of 1870, on exhibition at the World's Fair.

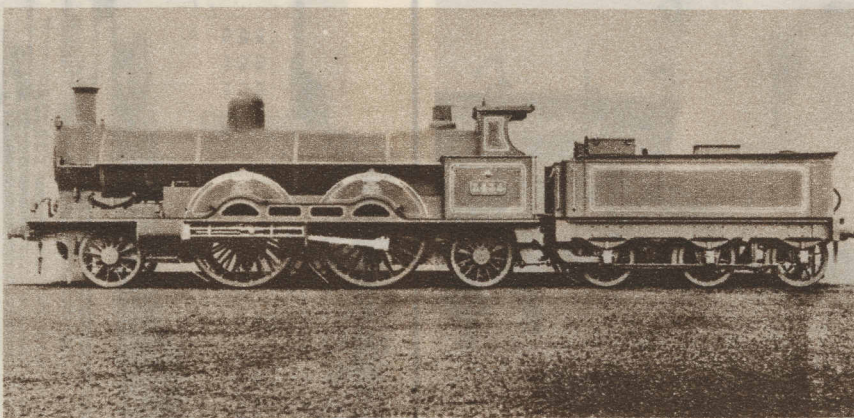

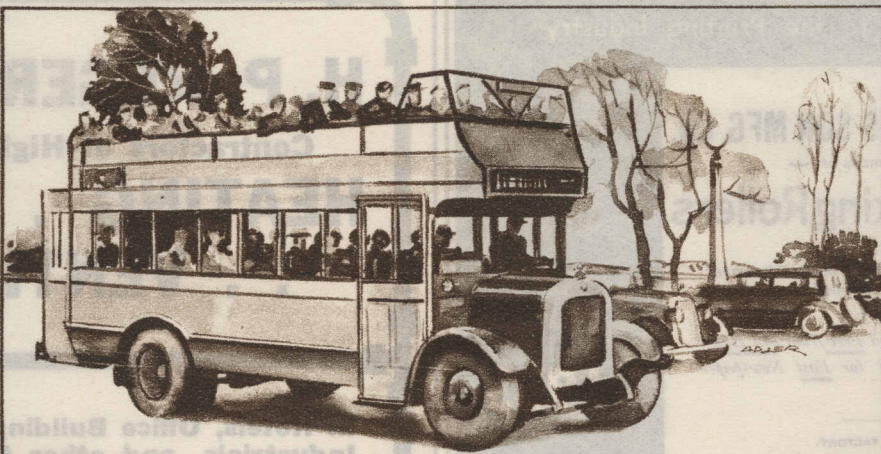

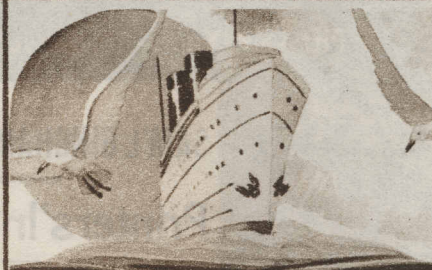
