


A NEW HOME FOR W-G-N IN TRIBUNE SQUARE



ADJOINING TRIBUNE TOWER (the lower stories of which appear at the right in the architect's model reproduced here) a new broadcasting studio is to be erected for the Tribune's radio station, W-G-N. Work will start immediately on the new structure, which will be ready for occupancy June 1, 1935.



THE NEW HOME of W-G-N, which will be constructed of Indiana limestone, will contain one large studio seating 600 guests, and in addition several smaller studios. The new building will constitute the second step in the development of Tribune Square.
