### **STIPULATED AWARD**

The parties have agreed to the following Agreement:

The City will make a one time payment within thirty (30) days of  $\frac{1}{2}$  of 1% of base salary only, which payment shall not be added to or used for calculating other benefits, including but not limited to, final average compensation for pension.
