CHANCHILLA CREAM.

MISS JESSIE PEASE.

1 qt. rich cream whipped to a stiff froth, add $\frac{3}{4}$ cups of pulverized sugar, $\frac{1}{2}$ box Cox's gelatine dissolved in a little water. Flavor to taste and place in a mould.

CHOCOLATE CARAMELS.

MISS MINNIE SAMSON.

1 lb. white sugar; little more than half a pt. of water, $\frac{1}{2}$ teaspoon cream tartar, 1 pt. sweet cream, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ozs. chocolate (pulverized). Put sugar, water and cream tartar together and boil about half an hour, add the chocolate, then stir in the cream so slowly that it will not stop boiling, as that will make it grain; try in cold water; do not have it too hard. Take off when done and stir in $\frac{1}{4}$ bottle of vanilla; pour on well greased platters; when cold cut in squares.

CREAM CANDY.

MISS CLARA NICHOLS.

1 lb. loaf sugar, 1 cup water, $\frac{1}{2}$ teaspoonful cream tartar, 2 of vanilla, 2 of vinegar, butter size of an egg. Boil until it hardens, when drop into water. When nearly cold pull as you would other candy.

1 lb. Babbitt's potash, 1 oz. ammonia, $\frac{1}{2}$ oz. salts of tartar, dissolve in 1 gallon soft water; jug and cork tight. One tea cup full to a boiler of clothes.

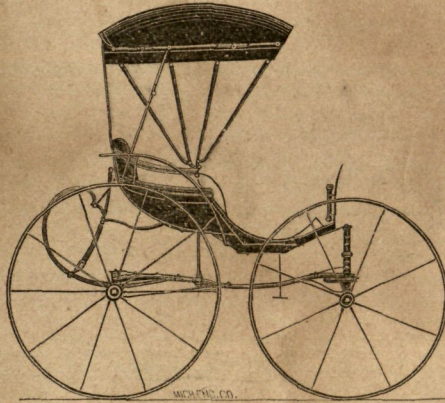
That in making a fruit or berry pie if the sugar is put in before the fruit, very little of the juice will escape.
