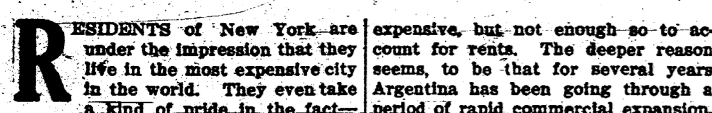


MOST EXPENSIVE CITY IN THE WORLD

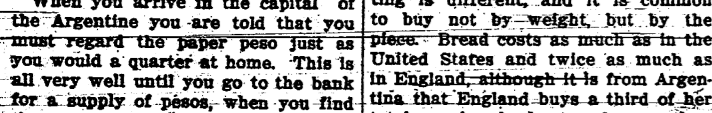
