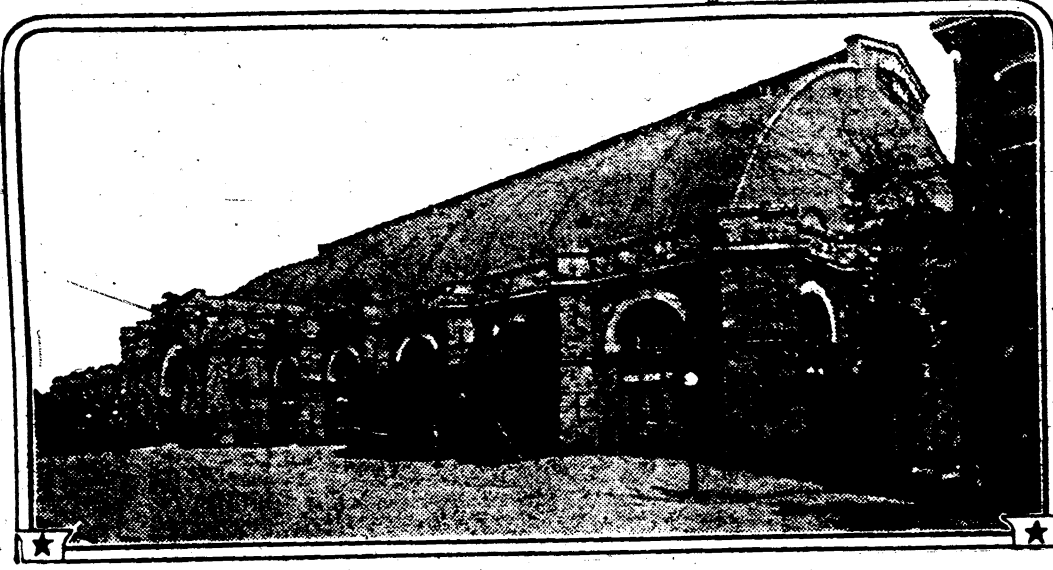

WILSON WINS ON 46TH BALLOT

Baltimore, Md., July 2, 1912. On the 46th Ballot Woodrow Wilson was Nominated as Presidential Candidate of the Democratic Party.

The Great Battle Ended in an Uproar and Tired Delegates Sighed With Relief From the Terrific Strain

WILSON'S ASCENT AND CLARK'S DECLINE SHOWN BY FIGURES.

Baltimore, July 1.—The democratic national convention shortly after midnight tonight adjourned until noon tomorrow. It was still deadlocked.

The Illinois delegation which was expected to swing to Wilson held a caucus on the floor of the convention tonight and decided to stand by Clark.

The feeling between the factions on the floor of the convention became tense today. Many of the delegates were angry over what they felt was a biased and unfair handling of the Wilson-Clark fight.

The deadlock that confronted the Democratic convention on Sunday was the most remarkable in the history of modern politics.

Having failed to nominate with the week-end it was not anticipated that the delegates would hurry to a decision on Monday and the fight might be prolonged for several days.

The Clark men still confident that enough of their delegates will remain steadfast to make the necessary one-third to prevent a nomination.

Michiganers Make Break. The break in the Indiana delegation to Wilson was the biggest single gain that he made in the course of the day's balloting.

The Clark men still declare they have absolute pledges from a sufficient number of men to block Wilson's nomination, even if he continues to gather strength.

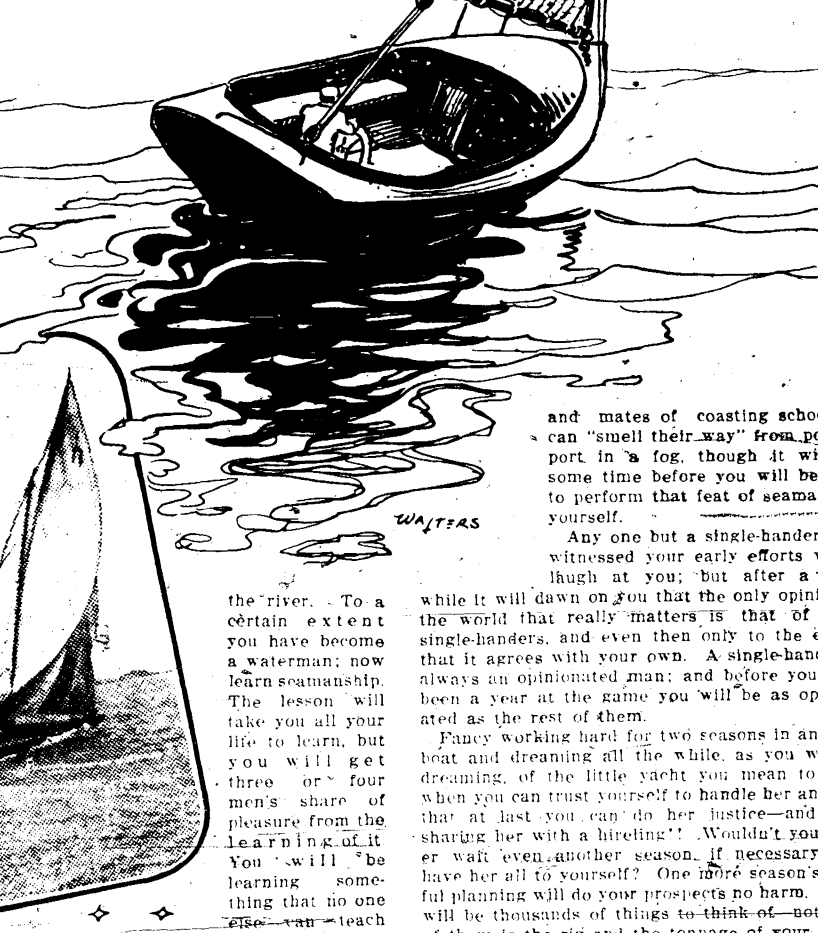
