FRENCH DRIVE GERMAN OUT OF TRENCHES AND RECAPTURE PART OF FORT.

Continuously Under Fire Berlin Also Makes Claim of Capturing More Than a Mile of British Trenches.

London—The French have recaptured part of Fort Douaumont, the only one of Verdun's ring of forts.

The Paris statement says that after a vigorous artillery preparation the French infantry stormed the hill, drove the Germans from trenches about a mile long and penetrated the fort.

Berlin also reported an attack by the Germans on the British front, saying the invaders captured more than a mile of trenches and inflicted heavy losses on the British.

With this attack on the British the Germans and Austrians are now engaged in an offensive which experts believe is the beginning of a new phase of the war.
