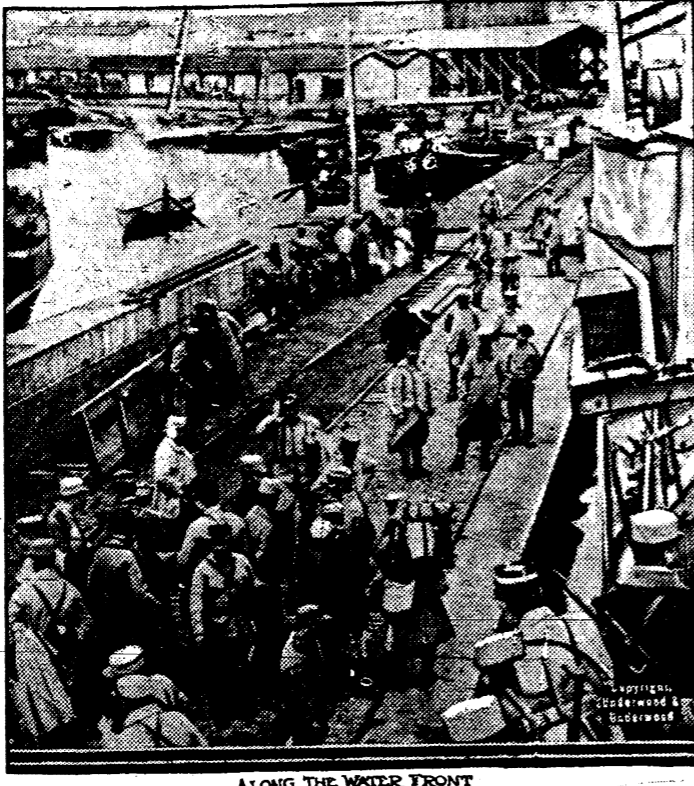

ALONG THE WATER FRONT

A STRIKING picture of street life in Soloniki, Greece, is given in a bulletin of the National Geographic Society, compiled from a communication to the society from H. G. Dwight.
