This is the gist of what occurred at Lansing when George A. Prescott, federal food administrator, who came to Michigan to see how the situation was being handled.

NEW GYM AT CUSTER UNDER WAY Soldiers Erecting \$25,000 Athletic Building at Cantonment.

Camp Custer, Battle Creek—Troop labor, under supervision of officers who in civil life were architectural and structural engineers, are erecting the \$25,000 camp gymnasium. The building will be located on the main esplanade, near division headquarters.

RESTRUCTURING MUST CLEAN UP Several Battle Creek Eating Places Found to Be Unsanitary.

Lansing—Restaurants and other eating establishments in Battle Creek must either clean up or close their doors, according to the health department. Officials in charge of the camp are determined to protect the men from food served under insanitary conditions.

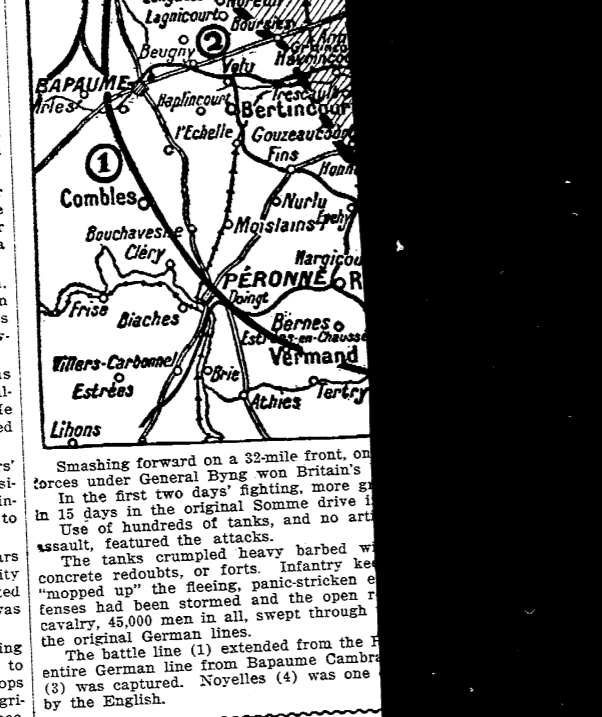
At the request of officials of the camp, the Michigan Food Commission has been making a sanitary survey of all eating places in Battle Creek, and as a result of the survey a number of proprietors will be asked to appear in court unless they give immediate heed to the health department's warning to clean up at once.

Conditions in some of the places are extremely detrimental to health, according to the report prepared by the dairy and food department. In one place the proprietors, according to the inspector's report, the dishes were washed in the same water used for the dishes to be served.
