CUT SWEET CLOVER EARLY. cially in this section of Michigan where a superior quality of gravel is Sweet clover for hay should be readily obtainable, roads can be kept cut early; just before the blessom in fine condition all the time at a buds appear. Sweet clover becomes

not nearly so palatable and does not make as good a hay as when cut at the earlier stage. This fact is over-leoked by many tarmers, since the alsike and red clover are usually cut after the blossoms have appeared.

Sweet clover does not propagate from a crown as does affaifa, and consequently the stubble should be cut high enough so that a number of branches will develop into the second crop, which may be used foreither hay or seed. If the crop is cut very close to the ground these branches will be removed and the second crop will not develop.
