## STATE LEADS IN GROWING FRUIT

Michigan Pears, Apples and Small Fruits Are Always in Great Demand Abroad.

Michigan stands first in the acreage devoted to small fruits, including strawberries, blackberries, raspberries, currants, dewberries, and loganberries. It stands third in the number of pear trees. The long stretch of territory bordering the St. Clair and St. Ignace Rivers in Michigan is famed afar for the favor of its pears; and the cultivation of grapes has increased rapidly during the last decade. For years, the state has ranked well up with New York and Maine in the production of Apples, frequently yielding a larger crop than any other state.

The total value of all orchard fruits has increased from \$9,020,842 in 1909 to \$15,599,735 in the census year 1919. The value of apples alone has increased from \$4,600,000 in 1909 to \$8,500,000 in 1919. The value of pears alone has increased from \$1,200,000 in 1909 to \$2,500,000 in 1919. The value of small fruits alone has increased from \$3,200,000 in 1909 to \$5,300,000 in 1919.

## SOILS SURVEY SEEN AS GUIDE TO BUYER

National Association Considers Michigan Survey.

This soil survey provides a valuable basis for the prospective land buyer, a standard for the banker, a guide for the farmer, and a general foundation for all future agricultural development. It is the contention of experts from all parts of the country who gathered at the Michigan Agricultural College, Nov. 15 and 16 for the second annual conference of the American Association of Soil Surveyors.

Twenty-four states, ranging from California to New York, and five Canadian provinces were represented by delegates who are the leaders in the soil survey work. For the first time a soil survey program in the different states and exchanged ideas on the most developments in the field marked the deliberations of the delegates.

A boost for the Michigan soil survey was started on a small scale two years ago by the soil department of the Michigan Agricultural College.

Some soil survey work has been done in every state in the Union. It is also taking up the work and will be organized in the future. In Canada, as in this country, the state or province carries out soil surveys. It has also a variety of French and New Latin names.
