OLD MILL PROPERTY MUCH IMPROVED

Tecumseh and Vicinity Get Benefit From Modernized Staunch Old Institution.

Way back in the early pioneer days Blanchard & Gardner, eastern mill owners and capitalists, constructed at Tecumseh what was for years afterward known as the Globe mills, but which for the past 50 years has been known as the Wm. Hayden mills.

The building itself was a gigantic structure, one of the largest in the country, and with its immense reservoir was considered a wonderful achievement in those days.

The owners also built a large dam on the Raisin river and constructed a wide and deep canal more than half a mile in length, through which the water flowed to the Globe mill pond, which was formed by damming Evans creek just above where it flowed into the Raisin river near the mill.

This mighty power has now been converted into a hydro-electric power plant connected with and operated by the Tecumseh Electric company plant further up the river, at what was known in ye olden days as the "Red" mill dam, long owned by the late Albert Anderson.

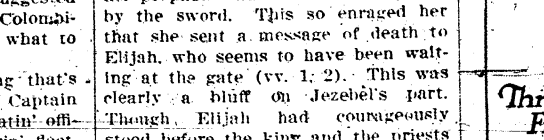

CARBON MONOXID WORKS QUICKLY
