British Debt Settlement—TO COST U. S. \$50,000,000 A YEAR IN INTEREST.

Washington—If the settlement of the British debt of nearly \$5,000,000,000 becomes effective, according to informed authorities, it will be made the basis for settlements with other debtor nations.

Five Killed, Auto Plunges in Creek—dagerstown, Md.—Three men and two women were killed when their automobile plunged into White Creek, near Cumberland, Md. One of the men has been identified as Edward Flynn, of Hagerstown.
