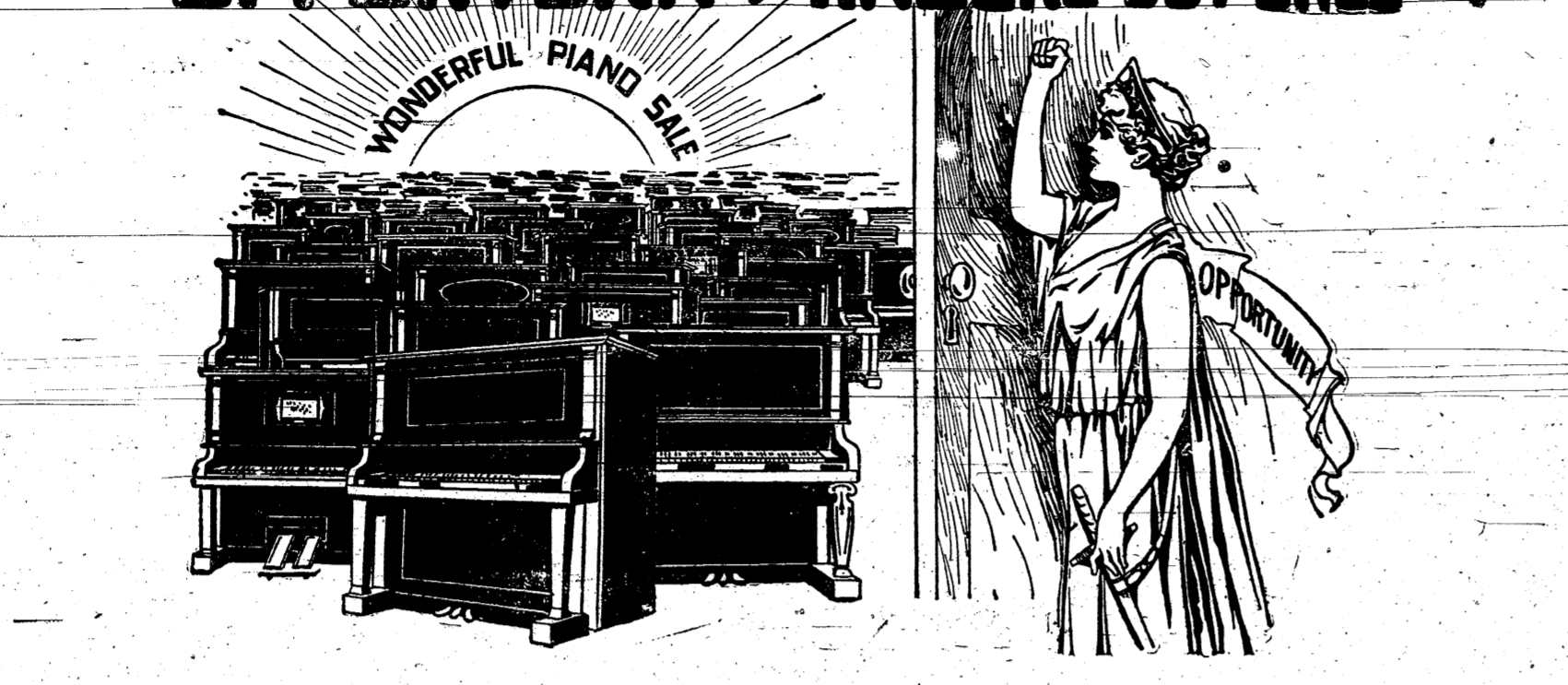

GERMANY FACES BILLS FROM \$1 UP

Treaties Attempt to Conquer World but Leaves Them Indebted to U. S. Alone for Billion and Half.

Washington, May 22.—America's bill of war claims against Germany amounts to \$1,479,623,322, according to a report presented to the mixed claims commission for settlement. The government itself is the largest claimant, asking for \$283,113,440, while the smallest of the 12,416 claims filed for \$1.00.
