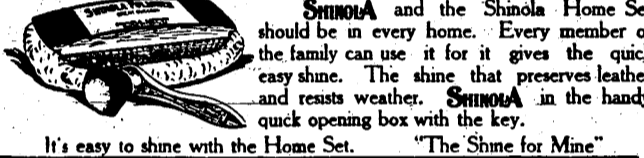

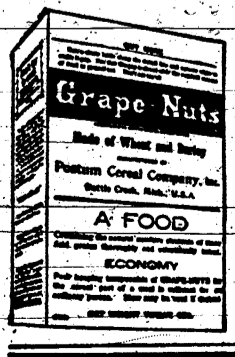

MODERN DUTCH COLONIAL HOUSE

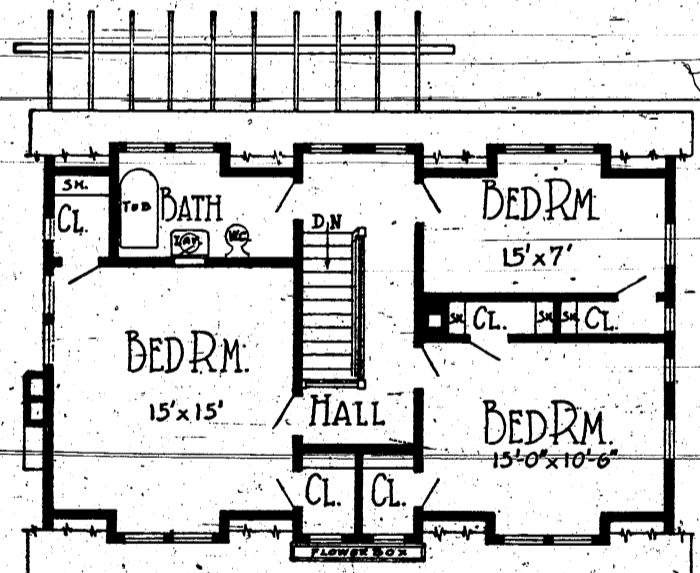
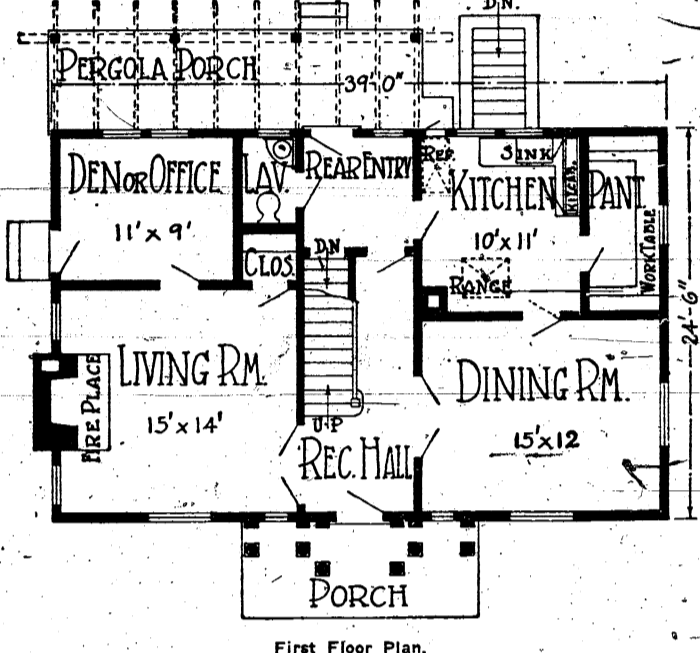
