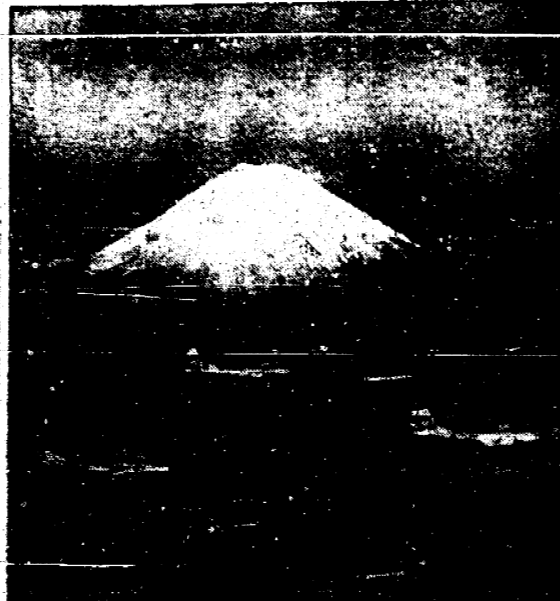

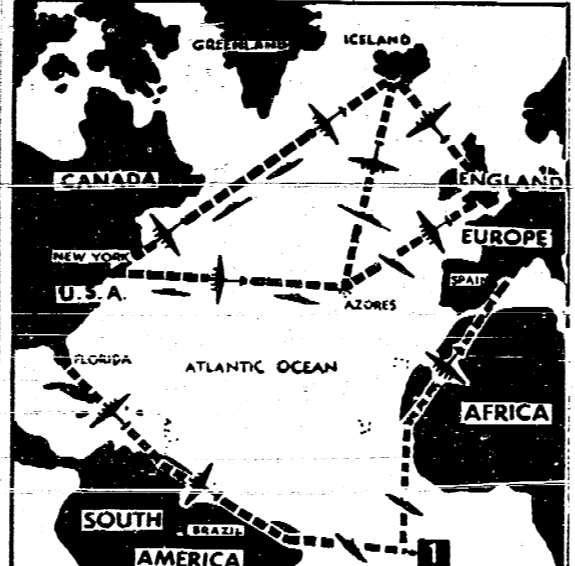

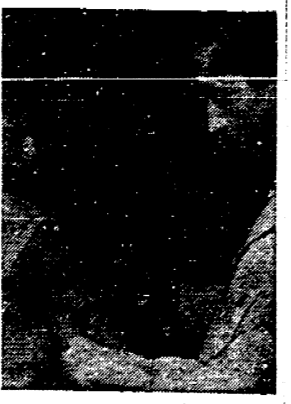

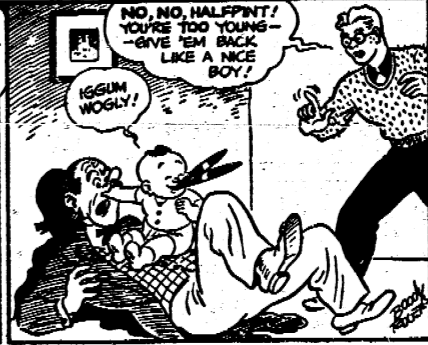

NEW DETROIT-CHICAGO HIGHWAY BEING PLANNED Plans to make Detroit the first American city to lead the nation in the annual billion dollar post-war highway program 804 under way there today when in progress for a Chicago-Detroit Expressway, linking the country's great industrial centers, was announced. The plan was submitted by the Automobile Club of Michigan to a group of highway officials and civic leaders. Similar meetings were held in Chicago under the sponsorship of the Chicago Motor Club.

While an exact routing of the new road was presented, it was pointed out that the present road facilities between the two cities are such that the U. S. Public Roads Administration recognized this as the second most needed highway in America today. The shortest route, according to the touring Bureau of the two organizations is 212 miles by way of US-20 and US-112. Ordinary traveling time is estimated at four hours.

Chas. T. Bush, Auto Club director and chairman of the Detroit-Chicago Expressway Committee, said the new expressway route will be shorter and cut the traveling time to five hours and would save hundreds of accidents and scores of lives annually.

Some important elements of the new highway are already in existence, such as the Willow Run Expressway which extends south-west for 17 miles from Detroit. While other portions have already been approved and will be started as soon as the highway programs of the states can get underway. The final location of the route will be determined and detailed plans developed by the appropriate state highway commissions with the approval of the Public Roads Administration.

Saving Nicotine Can Be Made by Practice Sufficient nicotine will be available unless extreme care is taken in its conservation. The average farmer wastes about half of the nicotine he purchases.

Don't dust with nicotine when weather is cold. Don't dust with wind is blowing. Don't run the fan too fast. Don't drive too fast. Don't delay application. Speed-up with a hand-duster. Treat the seed bed. Dip plants before transplanting. Keep plants growing vigorously.

Farm Accident Costs Continue to Mount Most Losses Can Be Prevented Entirely Accidents to farmers, in a typical year, cost double the amount of time needed to produce the average annual wheat crop of the United States. The economic loss from accidents of all kinds occurring to farm people is nearly a billion dollars per year. In a typical year, 17,200 farm people were killed, 4,500 were killed at agricultural work.

Storage of All Grains If grain and corn it to be saved from insect damage, they must be put in bins that are tight enough for gas treatment or fumigation. Before the grain or corn is stored, the crib or container should be thoroughly cleaned of old infested grain, even though it is planned to fumigate later. To kill insects in the walk, spray with an oil-soluble or other reliable spray. Empty feed bags and clean or dispose of and destroy all spoiled grain.
