Blat Superstitions

Many of the old notions about blats have been by the wayside in the case of recent research, according to the American Veterinary Medical Association. For example, blats in sheep and cattle usually from greater accumulation, not excessive production of gases. When Labor Becomes Partner in Industry
IF, AND WHEN, labor is recognized as a partner in production, then what is now paid labor as wages, and as such a part of the cost of production, might be considered as a dividend paid to a partner. Under such conditions both labor payments and interest on capital investment would be identical. Those dividends would not come directly out of the sales dollar, as would all other production costs, but out of the profit dollar. On the basis of wages paid to labor in that labor dividend would be an average of 25 cents out of each profit dollar. Feather Fabric Will Add to Your Income
America's poultry industry can produce 30 million men's suits annually. A new feather fabric that looks like wool but is warmer, softer and lighter, has been developed by USDA specialists. Feather protein is converted into fiber by treating the feathers with a reducing agent and a special type of wetting agent or detergent. In water solution, the fatting the resulting spinning solution, "dopes" through the tiny holes of a spinnerette into an industrial solution that sets the streams of dope into fibers. The fibers are then stretched and dried and treated to remove the detergent so that the regenerated protein is left in rope fiber form. It is not expected that feather fabrics, due to small quantities available, will ever become a serious commercial rival to the wool. Nevertheless, feathers do offer a potential income for the poultryman and will cooperate those with highest priced fabrics.
