

Washington Merry-go-round

PROSPECTIVE POLICY WASHINGTON—With Republican leaders gathering in the capital to begin organizing their own G.O.P.-ruled congress for the first time in 16 years, here is a merry-go-round view of what the country can expect during the next two years.

Golden Jubilee Dire Predictions on Founding Of R. F. D. Fail to Materialize

From a humble beginning in 1896 when four men on horseback and a boy on a bicycle embarked on the first experiment in carrying mail to rural areas, the rural free delivery service of the post office department has expanded to a \$100,000,000 enterprise as it notes the 50th anniversary of its establishment this year.

Financed by a congressional appropriation of \$40,000, the initial experiment of free mail delivery in Jefferson county, Va., was viewed by some as "a 10-cent gamble" and "ridiculous."

Others argued that mail delivered to the farmer would give him more opportunity to gather at the post office store and thus would destroy his social life.

Even some farmers were reluctant to sign up for the experiment, fearing it would isolate them from the rest of the community.

Small Offices Closed. Other postmasters were worried that the new system would eliminate the need for their little cross-country offices.

Some uneasiness was also expressed that farmers would be spoiled by a luxury service. They feared that the mail would bring city folk, but to the extent of refusing to sit from the house until the morning paper had been read.

Old Revolutionary Mine Discovered. In 1936, however, a bill providing for an experimental rural free delivery route received congressional approval. Three years later enough money was available to begin the West Virginia experiment.

Within nine months, R.F.D. had grown to 20 routes, operating from 48 post offices in 26 different states. Ten years later this number had increased to 87 routes covering nearly a million miles of road.

Now, on the 50th anniversary year, 22,111 rural routes are in operation, 432 of them in the United States. Thousands of friendly rural carriers, rain or shine, carry mail to nearly 10 million families along R.F.D. routes today.

Average length of R.F.D. routes is 8.42 miles. Longest route is 102 miles, shortest is 1/2 mile. Average from Glenham, Pa. Operating daily travel for the entire R.F.D. is 1,432,610 miles, or more than 87 times the distance around the earth at the equator.

Total expenditure for the R.F.D. during the fiscal year ending June 30, 1947, was \$106,946,321, representing a cost of \$3.50 a year per patron.

Transportation Varied. For years the mail was carried in buggies drawn by teams. Later specially built, weatherproof wagons were utilized. Now most persons on rural routes get mail delivered by automobile, of course, but there still are many routes in northern states where horses and sleighs are used in winter and some in mountain states where horseback delivery still is in vogue.

Wings for All Aim Of New Army School To Be Changed

WASHINGTON—Reorganization of six army schools was ordered by the war department in a move toward eventually giving wings to the infantry and all other ground forces.

The order, issued by General Dewey, ground forces commander, makes the air force school, both at Fort Benning, Ga.

An announcement said "plans call for all ground units eventually to be air transportable and the integration of the two schools under one name should make future activities more efficient."

Other schools to be reorganized include the coast artillery school, Fort Winfield Scott, Calif.; anti-air school, Fort Bliss, Texas; air cavalry school, Fort Riley, Kans.

In each case the order involves shifting headquarters activities to another school which the war department said would effect material savings in overhead and administrative personnel.

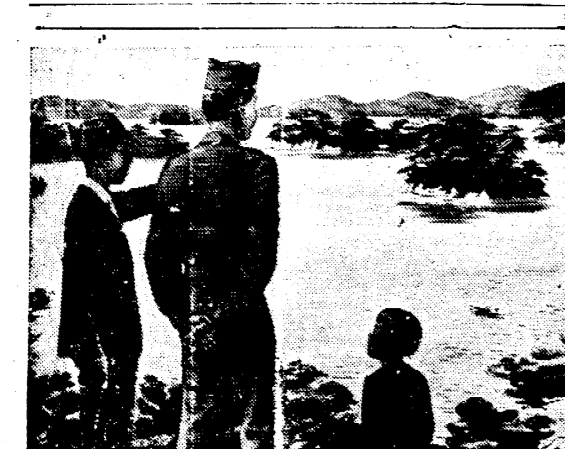
