**Bee Practices Show Efficient Progress**

Artificial insemination of bees has become a reality. The bee culture laboratory of the department of agriculture has developed a method by which queens can be fertilized artificially so that the queen bee breeds according to value and not to chance. Some bee raisers believe it is advisable to clip the wings of the queen bee, to prevent any wandering habit from developing.

When drone bees are spotted it is well to remove them, they are trouble makers. If they are not removed, however, the workers will soon kill them off.

When it is necessary to feed the bees, in winter, or periods of dearth shortage, ordinary sugar syrup is no longer recommended. By adding pollen to the syrup, egg laying starts within 12 hours. There is a wide variation, however, in content of the various nectars. High egg laying has been found associated with the gathering of nectar from mustards, mazzanti and sweet clover.

self. As a result, unionization has become widespread, and generally speaking, this union leadership is

irresponsible and incapable. The result is a chaotic situation. Labor and union organizers used large groups in organizing Michigan automobile workers. Security protection from the foreman, and wages in all three jobs the industry was largely at fault when they reached the age of 40 or so were let out of the industry because they were presumed to be too slow. The automobile industry, unfortunately, had neglected foreman training and had a large number of ardent socialist and unfair foremen; and "the industry was seasonal and the average employment was only about six months."

Management's recent "education" in human relations thus is being purchased at a costly price to workers stockholders and the suffering public.
