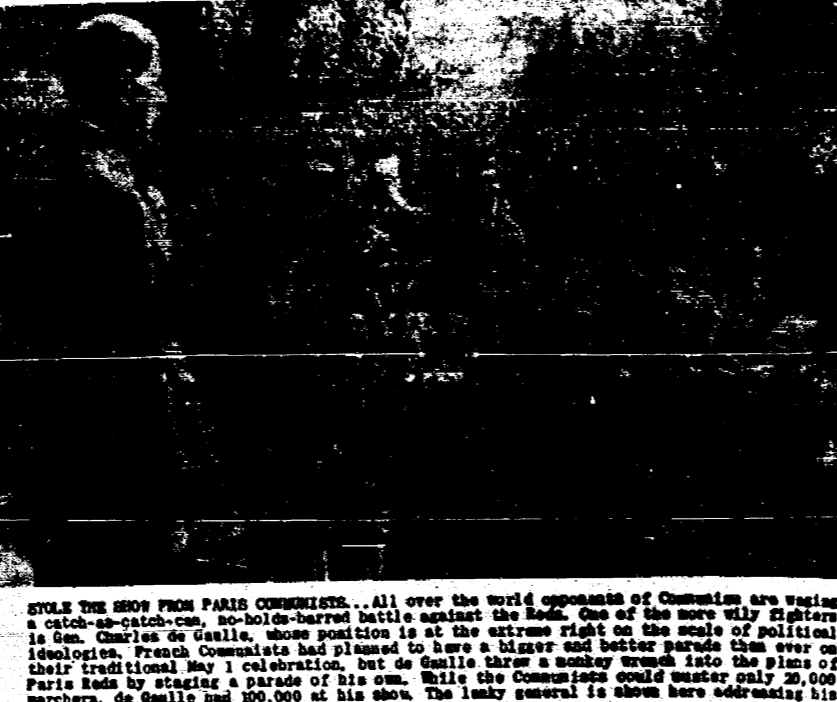

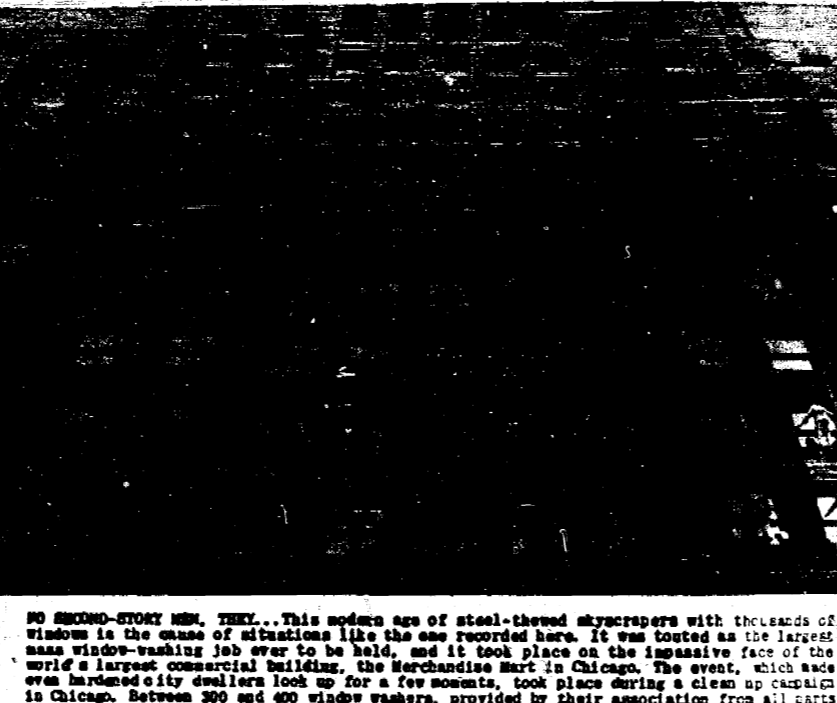

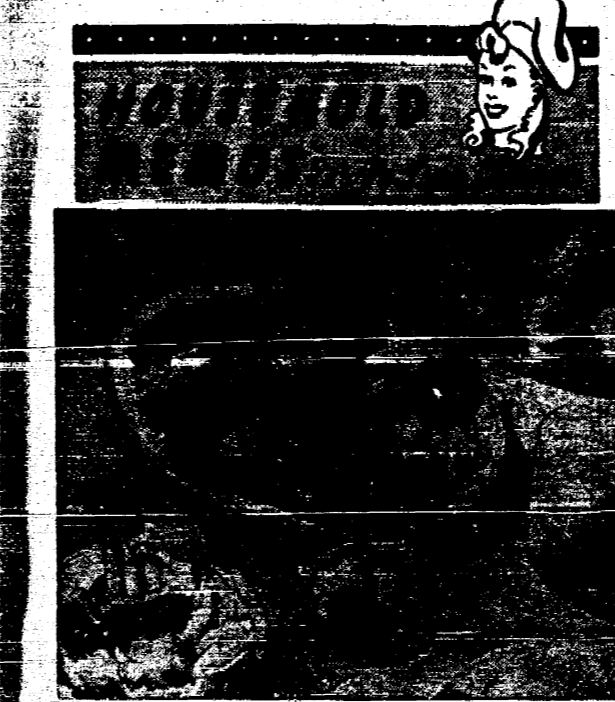



Conservation Department To Sell 21,000 Acres

More than 21,000 acres and 210 lots, including some water front lots, will be offered by the conservation department in a series of sales in upper peninsula courts during June 2-11. The sales will be the first offering of state lands in the upper peninsula since October.

Auctions begin at Escanaba June 2 with 1,272 acres in Schoharie county and 2,100 acres and 21 lots in Ontonagon county. Mackinac The Delta county lands include frontage on Moss Lake and Green Bay.

The auction schedule continues as follows:

June 3 at Menominee for 3,056 acres in Menominee county.

June 4 at Iron Mountain for 400 acres and 11 lots in Iron county and 1,925 acres and 15 lots in Dickinson county.

June 5 at Bessemer for 137 acres and 172 lots in Gogebic county.

June 7 at Ontonagon for 3,420 acres in Ontonagon county.

June 8 at L'Anse for 604 acres and four lots in Houghton county, including frontage on Pirage lake, and for 605 acres and one lot in Baraga county, including frontage on Keweenaw bay.

June 9 at Marquette for 1,549 acres in Marquette county and 417 acres in Alger county, with one bit of frontage on Betsie lake and mouth of Howe's lake.

June 10 at Sault Ste. Marie for 411 acres in Luce county and 2,982 acres and 38 lots in Chippewa county, with two parcels of frontage on Mosquito bay.

June 11 at St. Ignace for 1,252 acres and four lots in Mackinac county.

These one parcel useful for pasture are being offered subject to easements along streams, reserving fishermen's right of access and authority for stream improvements.

PHEASANTS SUFFER SEVERE SETBACK

After getting the first decent break on early spring weather in March and April, Michigan's pheasants now have suffered a severe setback in many areas from the May floods.

Conservation department game men believe the peak of the pheasant nesting season had not been reached when the surprise flood drowned some early nests. The extent of the loss is not yet known, but in some sections the birds' repeated practice of re-nesting when the first nest is lost will be tested.

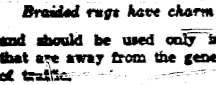

No one can refute the feeling that they add quiet, gentle touches to any home, and the intricacies of their making never fail to please.

If you need to relax and get away from the feeling of having things done at a certain time, like doing the laundry or sewing a dress, then try rug making. It's an occupation designed for relaxation.

Rug making can be done at odd moments, for a few minutes or a few hours. And there's wonderful satisfaction when the rug is finished, and you can remember it with pleasure every time you see it.

Materials for rug making usually can be found in every home, so you don't have to buy out a lot of money for this pleasurable work when you start. Woven fabrics in drawers and cupboards can be found in every home. So can outworn curtains, dresses, torn tablecloths, cotton bags and stockings.

All different kinds of fabrics won't go into one rug, but you'll find that these combinations can be worked together. Wool and wool-like rayons, cotton, linen and cotton-like rayon, silk, fragile rayons and nylon are expensive, but very desirable.

Fin Good Color

Choose a good idea to use colors indiscriminately when making rugs. Plan the colors with a definite room in mind. Pick up a wall or drapery color, or several of them, and build the rug around that.

If you're making a provincial rug with braid, you'll find that dark brown, tan and gold work well together. A nice oval rug can be carried out in dark green or jade green with a line of chartreuse green for a trim.

If you want to use red and gold with dark brown and golden brown, wine and old rose go well together, and will add quiet charm to a bedroom, study or hall.

It's wise to stick with two or three colors that harmonize perfectly. If there's need for brightness, confine it to more accents.
