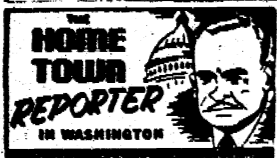

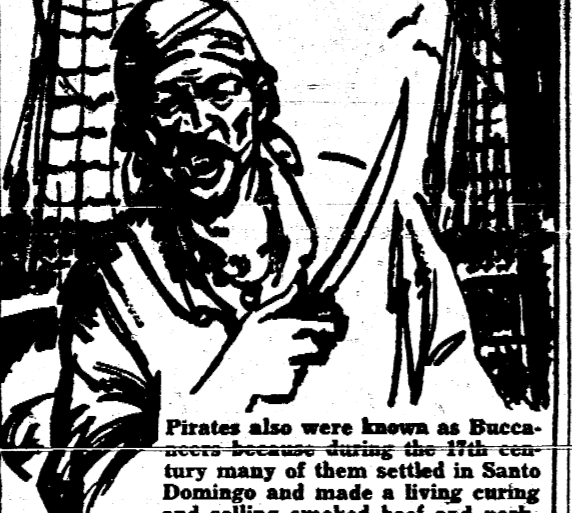

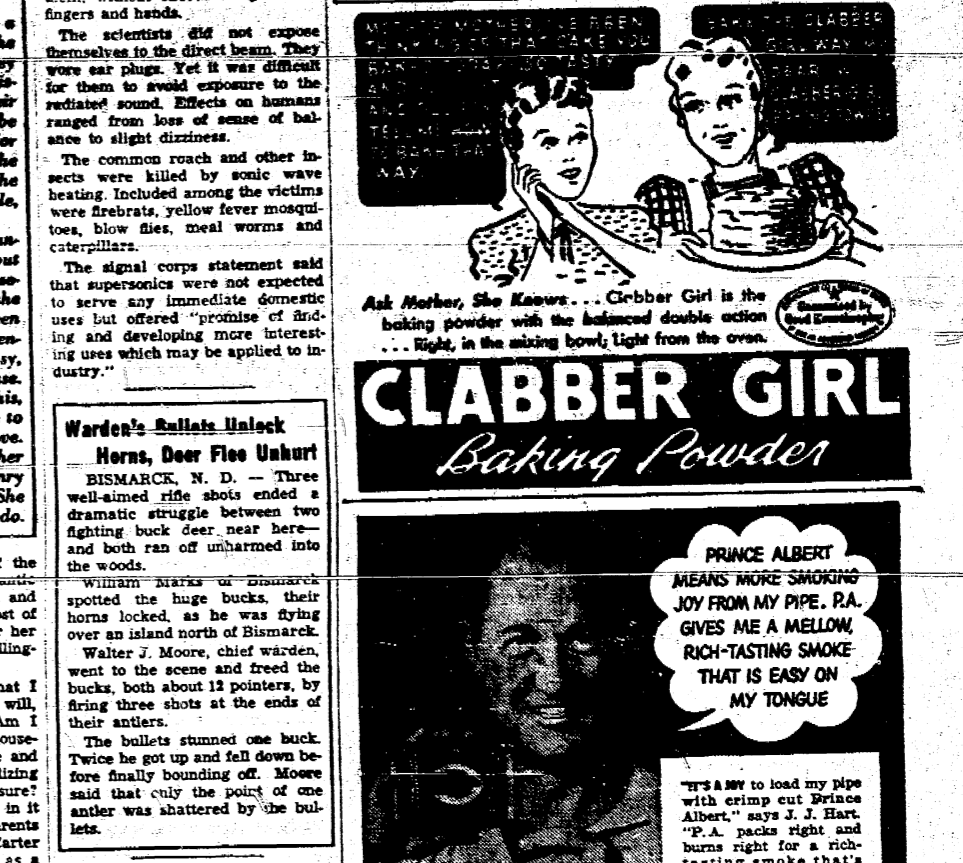

Conservation Department Appoints 56 New Officers

On January 19, next, an additional 56 conservation officers will take up the duties that are assigned to them.

These are men who will have completed a course of training that began last August. In the meantime, they will have had eight weeks of formal classroom instruction and nearly four months of training in the field.

Never in Conservation Department history have new officers been given such comprehensive training before assignment to duty.

Never have such qualifications been demanded. Completion of the weekly school, grade, emotional stability, resourcefulness, tact, alertness, willingness to be on call 24 hours a day and to live and work anywhere in the state at an assigned post... ability to pass rigid physical examinations.

Most of the new officers are World War II veterans, many have completed college courses.

With these 56 new officers, the Department's force is increased to 180 men. The new officers will be assigned to duties in both Peninsulas, most of them with "roving" status which will allow rapid concentration of men in "trouble areas."

Four new officers will devote full-time to inspection of commercial fishing operations.

1947 CHRISTMAS TREE SUPPLY

Final survey of figures by the Department of Agriculture shows that 1,125,000 Christmas trees were checked during the survey period prior to Christmas. Of this number, 983,937 trees were cut in Michigan, 91,423 were shipped from Canada, and 47,020 came from other states.

Trees must be accompanied by a bill of sale showing the description of the property from which they were cut and signed by the owner of the property. The Michigan State Police, Conservation Department and County Sheriffs cooperated with the Department of Agriculture in checking the trees.

Records show that 3378 passenger cars and 3949 trucks that were carrying trees and bought were checked. 5178 parties checked had legal bills of sale covering trees from their own property. 29 vehicles were found carrying trees with the tags attached, which is a violation of the nursery law unless a certificate of inspection also accompanied the trees. 618 trees were confiscated and 42 persons convicted for illegal possession of trees. The confiscated trees were given to the Percy Jones Hospital in Battle Creek for their Christmas season use.

Farm Economics To Be Stressed At MSC Farmers' Week Show

Farmers who attend the program by the Michigan State College of Agriculture and Mechanical Arts during Farmers' Week will find varied programs of interesting subjects. The program planned by the agricultural economics section will also stress farm problems of an economic nature.

Farm labor management will be the topic of the Tuesday morning session of the farm management department. Subjects such as labor efficiency and curing close time will be emphasized. The afternoon program will concern buying and selling farms in 1948 with discussions of land prices and farm values in farming.

Agricultural economics is presenting new developments in the re-handling of farm produce on Tuesday. Check Fur Coat Before Buying

With clothing prices sky high, many women are buying Mouton coats because they are moderate priced. These lamb skin coats will give warm wear and serviceability, but you should look for value just as you would with a wool or fur coat.

Before buying a Mouton coat, look for the following points:

First of all, see whether the fibers are flexible by blowing over the fur. The fur should part readily. It should feel smooth, silky and fall this way.

Examine the fibers separately to see if they are straight for at least half their length. Check to see that the fibers lie smoothly throughout the coat and that there are no cracks in the skins. Skins which have cracks where fibers extend in different directions are not desirable.

Because the best furs are made into the sleeves, check the back and front of the coat carefully.

Finally, look at the lining fabric and the workmanship on the coat, especially the stitching.
