



WORDS TO WATCH

The word protein, "a major food element of animal products," is often heard as "PRO-teen," a pronunciation which has little sanction. The dictionary consensus and Standard American usage give to the word three syllables, thus: PRO-tee-ia.

The companion word vitamin is pronounced: YY-tuk-min. An older spelling "vitamine," is now obsolete, although a few dictionaries carry it as a second choice. It was variously pronounced "VY-tuk-myn," none of which are now good usage. Use the spelling "vitamin" and pronounce it: YY-tuk-min,
