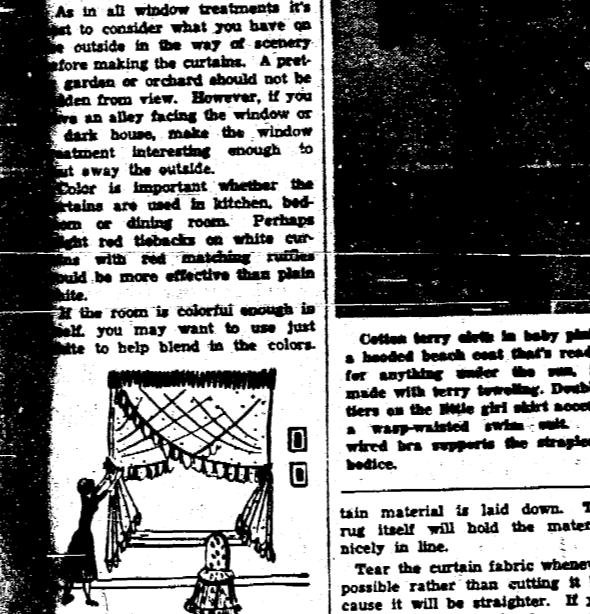

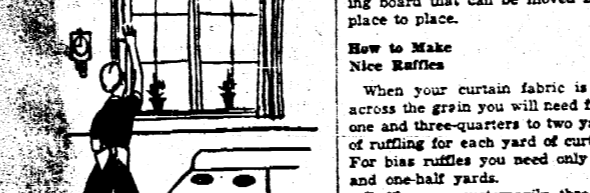
Woman's World Rooms Get That New Look With Crisp, Bright Curtains

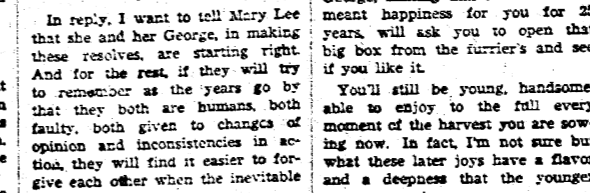
