Farm Legislation Due SINCE the farmers of the nation played the leading role in returning President Harry S. Truman to the White House, even more so than labor, it is practical to assume that on the early agenda of the Democratic 81st congress will be some sorely needed farm legislation.

Another early act likely will be a modification of the Federal Reserve Act to give the Federal Reserve Board authority to issue credit expansion to farm trucks and tractors exclusively in the transportation of agricultural commodities.

Early ratification of the international wheat agreement set, a new loan-advance farm price support program, plus acreage control, additional funds for conservation, reclamation and irrigation, for such farm programs and for rural electrification are almost certain of enactment.
