

"HIT EM WHERE THEY AIN'T"
Back in 1906 some reporters sat on the bench of the New York Highlanders, now better known as the Yankees, in the art of hitting. One day earlier Keeler had made five hits in a rew; but chased by the pitcher, first but chased what he had to say to the kids of America on how to become a great hitter, Keeler simply replied, "Hit 'em where they ain't." There may never be another hitter just like Keeler . he had no power and the outfielders knew it and played in ciose . . . yet he always batted better than 309.
