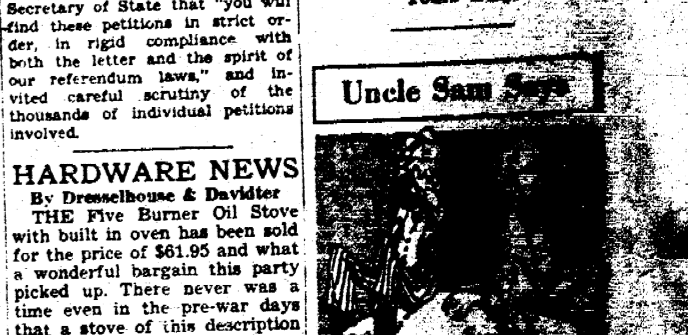
Safety Patrol on Guard as School Bells Ring
