## Rural **Z**ele-news



NIPS TROUBLE IN THE BUD-Special equipment in the telephone central office tells the approximate location of cable trouble miles away. A tone is sent out over the wires. Then a repairman out on the line moves an electrical instrument called a "Cable Bug" along the cable until he no longer hears the tone. Right at that spot he opens the cable and finds the trouble. Another example of how fast and economical methods have been developed to do difficult telephone jobs.

ASTRONOMICAL FIGURES - To serve its customers, Michigan Bell has some 6,000,000 miles of wire and 822,000 telephone poles in Michigan. The wire is equal to 25 single strands stretched from here to the moon. The poles, if "planted" 40 feet apart, would form an "orchard" of 7,548 acres. Money for poles, wire and other equipment needed to provide service comes from folks who invest a part of their savings in the telephone busine and expect a fair return on their investmen


