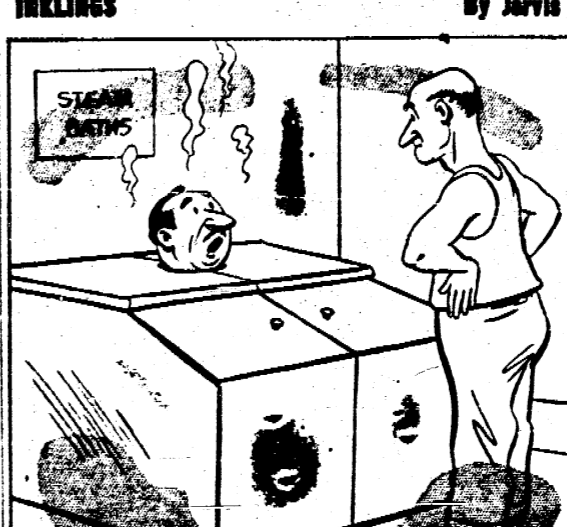
Observing Rules is 'Must' When Home Cooks Make Dishes of Cheese, Eggs

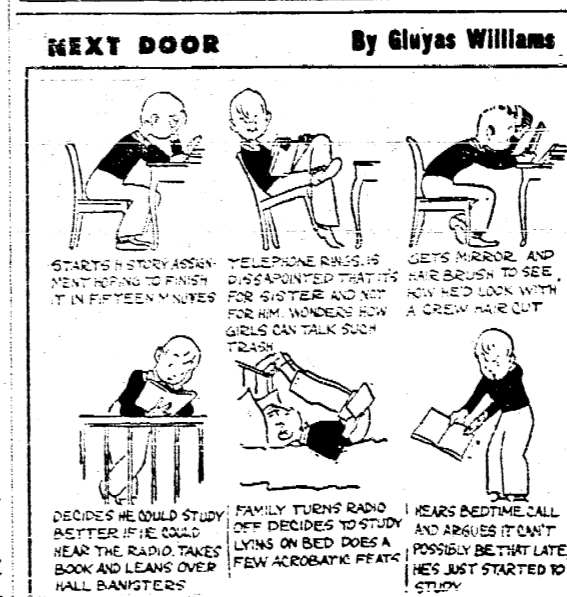
