



Increased production is diverting large quantities of milk and cream into the production of dry skim milk and butter in Michigan. Eastern markets for evaporated milk and sweet cream are being supplied from other sources and much of Michigan's milk supply formerly going into those products, is now going into butter and dry skim milk, according to F. M. Skiver, Chief of Dairying, Michigan Department of Agriculture.

He reports the production of Michigan milk plants so far in 1949 is 3 to 5 per cent above 1948. With less cows being milked the increased production is apparently due to better culling of herds and better feeding of cows milking.

At the present time much of the sweet cream produced by large plants is being churned into sweet cream butter. This is

the sweet cream produced by to be grown this year include large plants is being churned into sweet cream butter. This is the best quality butter and is bringing top prices on some of the eastern markets.

Some of the fluid milk markets are now shifting surplus milk to manufacturing plants. and

ets are now shifting surplus milk to manufacturing plants, and when the peak of production comes in June, million of pounds of milk will be manufactured into butter and dry skim milk, the usual forms in which seasonal milk is stored. Mr. Skiver estimates that butter and dry skim milk production in Michigan this year will probably be 10 per cent higher than in 1948.







> Umpires Soon Superflous As Device Marks Foul Hits WASHINGTON .- Base hit or foul ball? Soon fans will be advising umpires to go and have their eyes examined, after calling a close one just inside or just outside the foul

To take this wrangle-causing un-certainty out of baseball a Wash-ington inventor, Allen K. Nelson, has devised what he calls a foul has devised what he calls a foul ball indicator. It consists of a post, to be set at the far end of the outfield on the foul line, with a pair of crossarms from which a series of free-swinging rods are suspended. Half the rods are thus in "fair" territory, the other half in "foul." Electrical connections from the rods are so arranged that if a batted ball bits one of the rods on the "fair" side it will cause a green lamp to light up, while if the impact is against a rod on the "foul" side a red signal will be flashed to the batter—and he'll have to wait for a better ball.


