





Pros & Cons
President Truman's sweeping
new farm program met with mixed
response on Capitol Hill. Critics
claimed it would carry the nation
closer to socialism and would empower the government with un-precedented farm controls and

PROPONENTS of the measure contended that consumers would be benefited because retail food prices would be sllowed to seek their own level.

No matter which school of thought was correct, it was inescapable that the program would use taxpayers dollars to guarantee farmers an income equal to that of a recent 10-year period.
