Red Wheat Shipped West By Water

Farmers in Ohio, Indiana and Michigan have profited by large-scale demonstration of how grain received by trucks directly from farms can be shipped by water to distant markets with only "one-stop" supervision, according to Harold Anderson, head of the Anderson Truck-Terminal.

The demonstration was the shipment to Duluth, Minn., late last month of 100,000 bushels of soft red wheat harvested in this section in July and brought to the Anderson terminal in farm trucks from the three states. The grain was loaded into a 50-car freight train which was switched to the Maumee River docks, and then loaded into the 7,000 ton freighter. Since J. Murphy.

Savings in transportation costs thus accumulated were passed to farmers in the form of higher grain prices, and at the Toledo market were 2 to 3 cents higher than rates to Duluth for grain from Toledo are nearly 30 cents a bushel lower than the rail rates which was the deciding factor in creating the Dutch order for grain raised in this area. The shipment was significant also because it moved west from Toledo into an area that is a major grain center, instead of in the normal direction of east. Mr. Anderson reported that it was only the second time in his 30 years of experience in

grain distribution that such a shipment was made, a situation, he said, that was "like carrying coal to Newcastle."

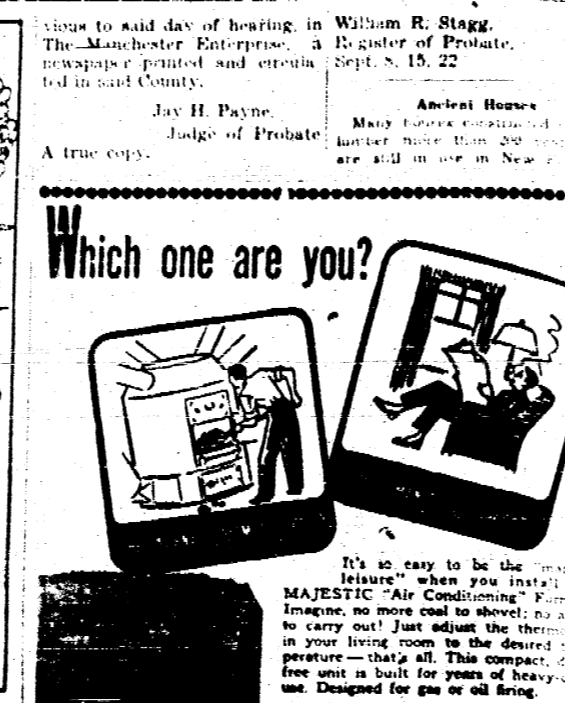
A large surplus of red wheat in this territory, coupled with damage to hard wheat crops in the Southwest and Northwest this year, has caused lower cash prices in Ohio than westward. Mr. Anderson said. Thus, there is a demand in the west for this territory's red wheat, suitable for making crackers and pastry, while the west's hard wheat, used principally for bread flour, continues to move in large volume to eastern millers.

That the big shipment went to Duluth instead of to some other port is secondary, in his opinion, he said. The fact that it marks the beginning of a service which may make the market for grain raised in this section, Mr. Anderson believes. His terminal already has inquired from grain shippers in Canada and throughout the East, as well as in other cities west on the Great Lakes, who are interested in developing water transportation.

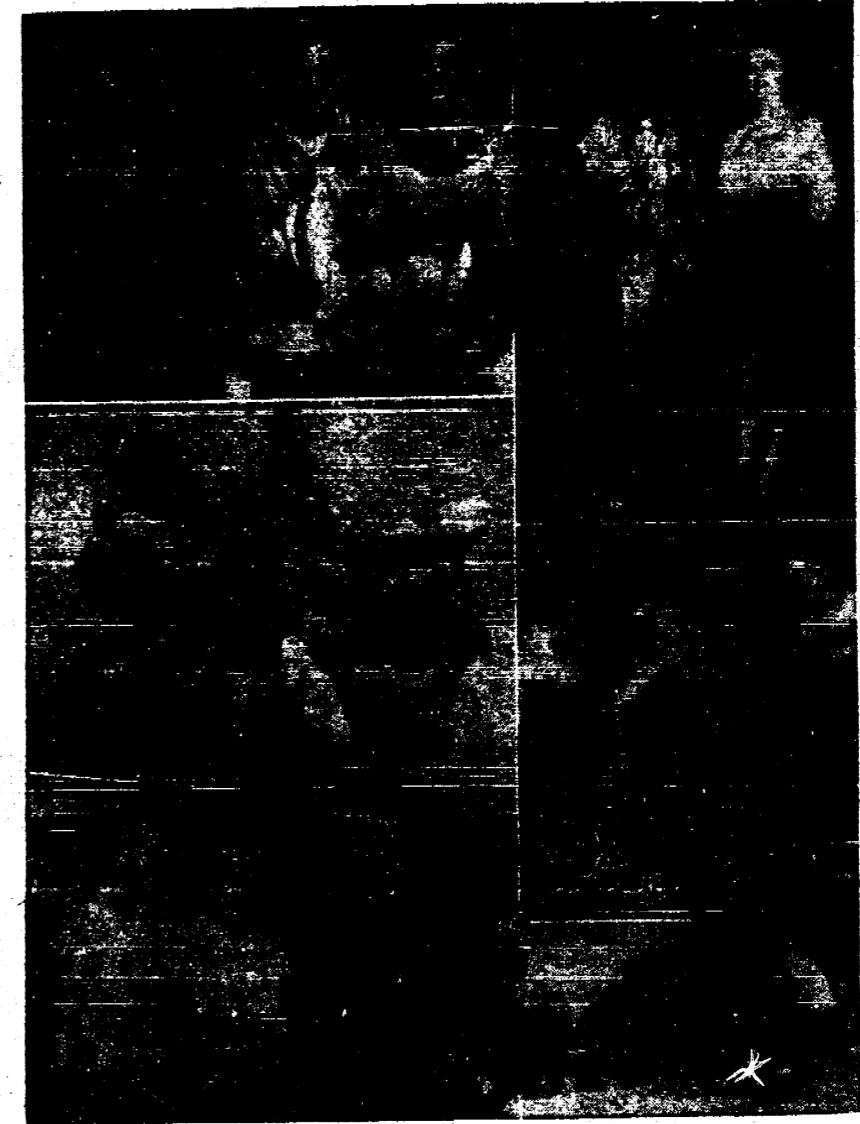
