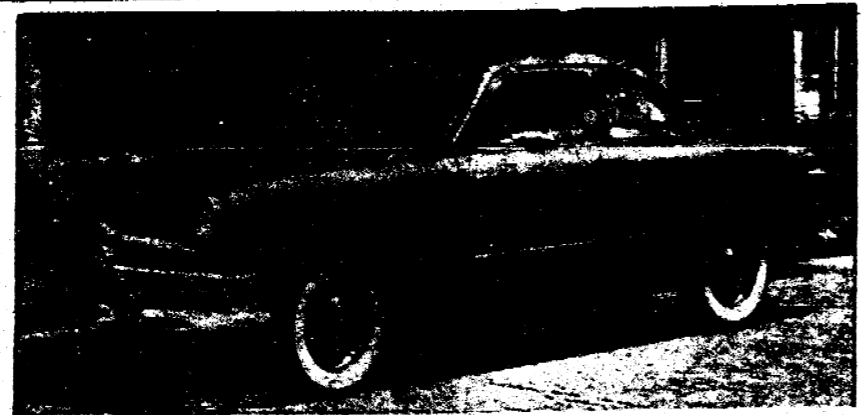

1. Arrive at the hospital at least 15 minutes before the time you are to give blood.
2. Register at the hospital and receive a card which you will use to identify your blood.
3. Go to the blood bank and give your blood.
4. After giving your blood, you will be given a small amount of juice and a glass of water.
5. You will be given a certificate of appreciation for your blood.
