

Complaints of rats increase rapidly with cooler weather. Rats which have been out-of-doors move into buildings for protection during fall and winter. Ratproofing corneribs. dwelling houses, or other buildings deprives rats of their winter home and food. Where rats gain entrance to buildings, they may be killed.

Breeding ewes should be kept in thrifty condition during the winter. Ordinarily, young ewes do not need grain until the last four to six weeks before lambing time. Pasture and legume hay, or two to three rounds of silage per head daily plus the legume hay should be sufficient during the first part of the restation period.
