# THE DOT COLUMN

For the first time in almost a year, farm prices in Michigan were at 100 percent of parity. All of the indexes in the first table were above their June levels. Up most were prices received by Michigan farmers which jumped twelve points. Prices paid rose only one point. Industrial production in June was 24 percent more than a

year ago and 3 percent higher than May. The cost of living was only up 1 point from May to June.

Contributing most to the rise in all farm prices were hog and cattle prices which rose \$2.50 and \$2.30, respectively, per hundredweight. Grain prices rose moderately from June to July but were well above prices of a year ago. Hay was the only commodity to register a drop from June to July.

All livestock feed ratios rose during the month since livestock product prices increased more than feed prices. All feed ratios are at or above pre-war levels, except the egg-feed ratio which is still about 3 percent

below pre-war.

**Peaches Can Be Successfully Frozen**

Peaches make an excellent frozen product but are more difficult to prepare than some other products. Some precautions in preparing them for freezing will give you delicious fresh peaches for next winter's difficult meals, advises Roberta Hershey, extension specialist at Michigan State College.

Recommended varieties for freezing are J. H. Hale, Hale Haven, Elberta and Red Haven. They should be harvested at the stage of firm ripeness but not softness. Avoid bruising by excessive handling.

Rapid preparation is essential to prevent browning. Peel, remove pits and cut each half into 4 to 6 pieces. Pack quickly into containers leaving as little headspace as possible. Peaches

should be covered with syrup made of equal parts of sugar and water and containing ascorbic acid.

Ascorbic acid is added to peaches to prevent them from turning dark. It is easily added to the syrup just before it is poured over the fruit. It can be purchased in crystalline or tablet form and three-fourths teaspoon of the crystals or 1000 milligrams in tablet form should be added to each quart of cool syrup. Syrups may be made with either hot or cold water but must be cooled before pouring over the fruit. A piece of crumpled waxed paper placed under the lid of the container will hold the fruit down under the syrup so that the pieces on top will not turn dark.

**Farmers-Sportsmen All Benefit By Williamson Plan**

Applications for participation in the Williamson controlled hunting plan are lagging with the September 10 deadline near.

the conservation department. The department's game division reminds interested southern Michigan farmers that the hunting season is only a few weeks away and urges them to make application soon so that necessary signs and tickets can be ready.

The Williamson plan is designed to help the farmer in controlling his hunting season trespass problem and at the same time provide sportmen with hunting areas which are not overcrowded. The plan calls for posting of lands by cooperative farmer groups and allows hunting by written permit.

Costs of printing tickets and boundary, gate and safety zone signs are paid by the conservation department.

Those unfamiliar with the Williamson plan can get further information by writing to F. W. Stuever, conservation department's game division at Lansing.

First clubs to apply this year are the Grand River Valley Hunting Club, Ionia, Eaton and Clinton counties; L. S. 27 Game Club, Dewitt, Clinton county; Male Hill Protective Association, Grandville, Kent county; Delta Conservation Club, Eaton county; and the Rush Township Club, Shiawassee county.

John R. Vloch, Farm Labor Specialist for this area, reports that there is a critical shortage of farm help at the present time. That is, help for seasonal and year-round work. He therefore urges farmers to report their needs immediately to the local employment office so that the local office, and Farm Labor Specialist in those offices can process immediately any applicants looking for farm work. Tomato pickers are starting to migrate from the Traverse City area, and that type of labor must be placed immediately or they will continue on to other states.

Therefore, Mr. Vloch suggests that anyone that is needing tomato pickers should report their needs immediately to one of the local offices, so that people migrating from the Traverse area can be referred to those jobs immediately. He also suggests that if anyone in this area knows of persons that are desirous of obtaining a farm job, either year-round or seasonal, that person should report the idea help immediately to one of our local employment offices. Offices are located in Monroe, Adrian, Ypsilanti, Ann Arbor and Wayne for this area. The office phone number at Monroe is 1096, at Adrian 490, at Ann Arbor 2-4491, at Ypsilanti 374 and in Wayne 3735.

He reports that there are any number of jobs open for year-round help, both single and married men, and anyone that is desirous of obtaining a year-round job should contact one of these numbers. All offices will be glad to give you full information on the job openings at the present time and he again urges anyone knowing the whereabouts of any idle farm labor to report it immediately to one of these offices so that it may be utilized in this area.
