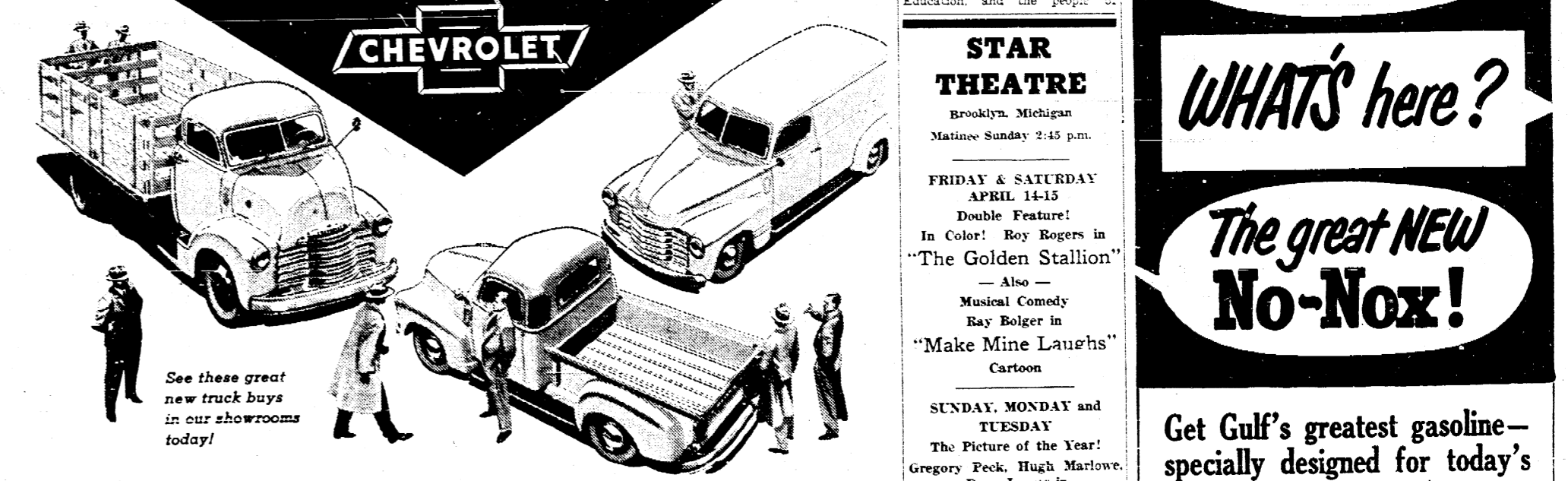

Rural Tele-news

Hunting and Fishing

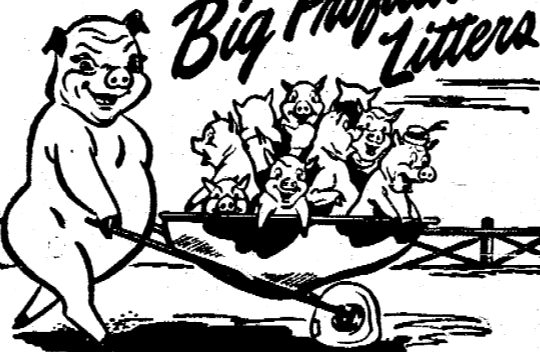
Hunting and fishing license sales reported by state agents through March 31 bolster several 1949 record figures but do not equal the 1948 record mark. Latest conservation department tabulations show 371,822 resident deer licenses compared to the 1948 all time high of 373,146. The mark will be tied or exceeded, says department license chief A. L. McNeil, who is counting on scattered final agents reports.

Incomplete returns already reveal a record 815,577 resident anglers. Other records include trout stamps, 179,916; annual nonresident fishermen, 122,868; resident bow and arrow deer hunters, 11,826; and nonresident small game hunters, 3,927. The 617,741 small game licenses reported sold by agents tops the 1948 final of 583,360. Revenue from total license sales recorded through March 31 amounts to \$5,058,515. Final revenue tally for 1949 was \$4,628,711.

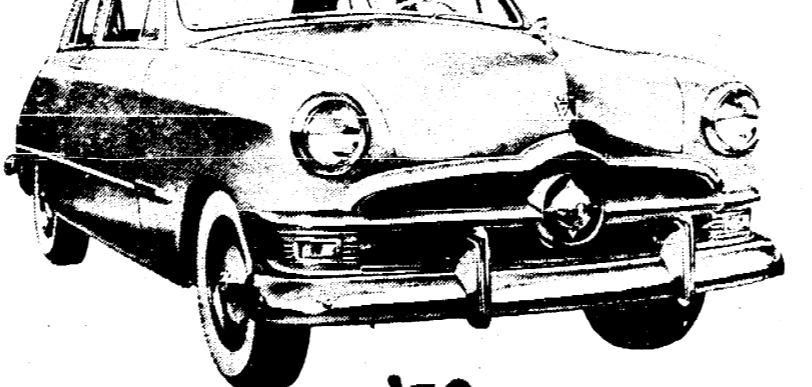

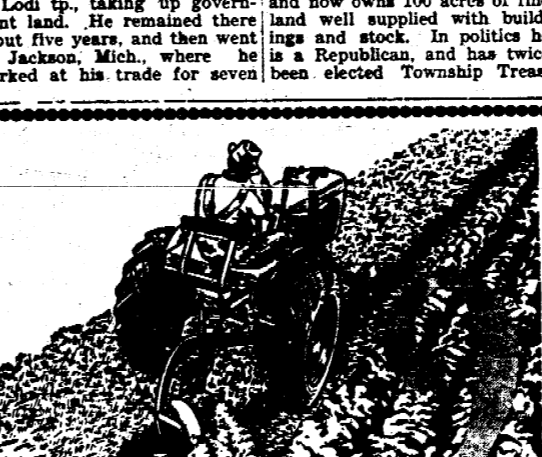
