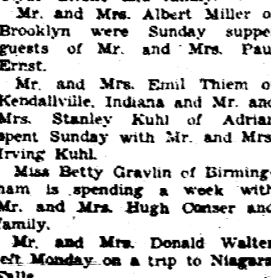

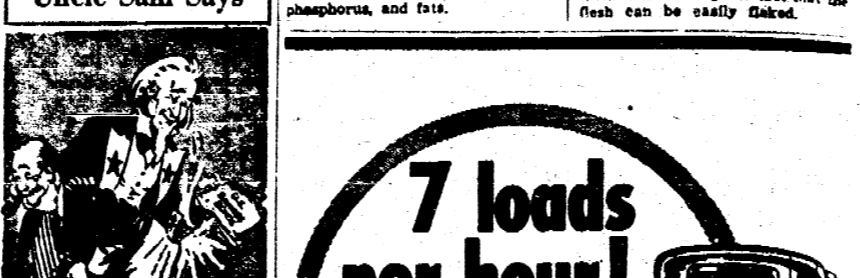

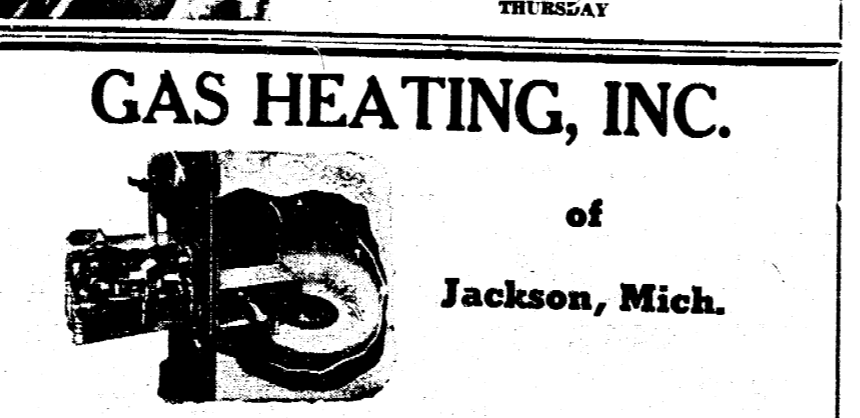

Will Be Greatest Convocation of Churches in History

The long-cherished hope of a single statement through which the churches may work together to strengthen Christian influence in all areas of life in America will become a reality.

After ten years of planning under the direction of the Rev. Dr. Luther A. Weigle, dean emeritus of the University of Chicago, the National Council of Churches of Christ in America will become an accomplished fact.

The convocation, which will be held in Cleveland, Ohio, on the 25th and 26th of August, will be the largest gathering of church leaders in the history of the world.

The National Council has been constituted by at least 26 communions, including the majority of the major Protestant denominations and four Eastern Orthodox bodies.

It will coordinate the programs of a dozen or more interdenominational agencies such as the International Council of Religious Education, Federal Council of Churches, Church World Service and the Protestant Radio Commission.

Others are the Home Missions Council of North America, the Foreign Missions Conference of North America, Missionary Education Movement of the U. S. and Canada, National Protestant Council on Higher Education, United Stewardship Council and

World Council of Churches.

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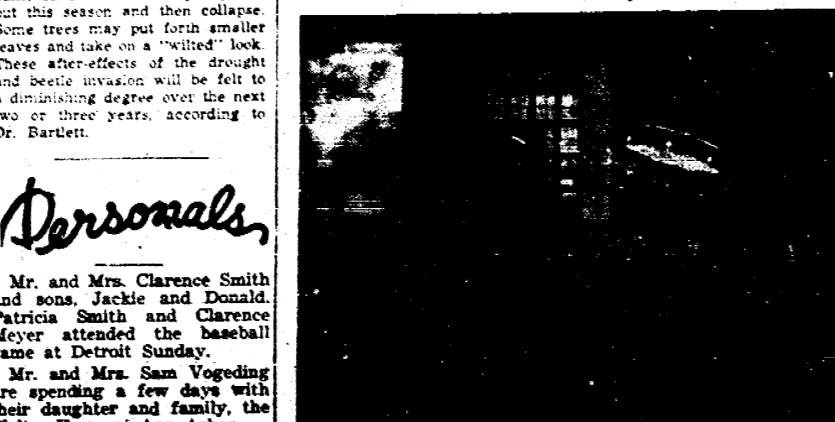
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Light Your Garden Furniture For Gay Outdoor Living

Mare Phoney Maney Pushed In 1949, Report States WASHINGTON. — Secret Service Chief U. E. Baughman has reported public losses from counterfeit money more than tripled from 1948 to 1949, jumping from \$100,132 to \$303,445.

This marked the highest peak in phony money deals since 1930 when the public lost a record \$1,027,265, he said.

Another \$703,423 in bogus bills brought 478 arrests in 1949, some suspects had not yet been tried, but 277 persons were convicted on counterfeiting charges last year, the report said.

Woman Told of House On Fire Goes to Bed WASHINGTON. — A woman apparently so sleepy she forgot to bed after being told her house was on fire, was rescued by police and firemen after a second try.

Police were investigating an automobile accident when they saw smoke billowing from the house of Mrs. Collette Schneider, 47, of 1212 E. 12th St., Detroit. Mrs. Schneider came to the window, was informed her house was on fire, but went back to bed.

Officers and firemen aroused her by banging on the door and lifting the window and asked whether there were any other occupants in the house.

She said that her 10-year-old daughter still was in bed. The rescuers forced their way back into the building and found the bed empty.

The firemen learned that the woman was mistaken and that the child stayed in a private school and visited only on the week ends.
