Michigan's major highways, which (or Ottawa) Trail, has become the comprise one of the finest road-systems in the nation, were at one time only faint trails over which passed moccasined feet as Indians traveled to hunting grounds and tribal gatherings.

It was native Indians of the state who were responsible in large part for the routes followed by our modern highways, says Dr. Floyd Stigenbauer, professor of geography at Wayne University in Detroit, after reviewing the travel networks of the past.

The red-skinned engineers, who planned the quickest means of travel along waterwayr and other routes of few obstacles, laid out their trails without surveying instruments. Yet modern engineers liked the results so well that the great thoroughfares we see today closely parallel the comman routes.

Such a trail was the Potswatomi, which ran from Detroit or Chicago. At Ypsilanti the Sauk Trail, coming from the south, joined it to form a fork. Today the fork renains; the Potawatomi trail now being U.S. 12, and the Sauk Trail U.S. 112.





The act referred to is the one under which county hospitals are established.

Bandaging Dog's Tail A long-time problem of veterinar-lans—how to keep bandages in place on monkeys' and dogs' tails—may be solved in the future by use of stainless steel tubes. English veterinarians are experimenting with rimanais steel tubes as surgical dressings for injured tails. Dogs and monkeys are noted for tampering with bandages, often biting or pulling off dressings meant to protect wounds. Steel tubes promote tect wounds, sieet tubes promote healing by protecting the wounded tall from further injuries resulting from biting or scrat'thing, allow free ventilation of the wound and make it easy for veterinarinans to observe how healing is progressing.


