Onion Fields On Walton Farms Get Second Dusting From Aircraft

Onion fields at the Walton farm on each row were given their second dusting by plane on Monday evening. This method is done by plane rather than by spraying the onion plants, and a broom-like machinery in order not to injure the onion plants, and at the same time give adequate protection against fly and midge.

Although fairly new to this locality, the dusting by plane operation is not new to the Walton farm. They have used this method of insect control for the past 3 or 4 years.

Mr. Walton has a 50 acre tract of onion fields on his farm on each row and another 80 acres of onion up near Fletcher.

During the season it is the custom to have the dusting done 3 or 4 times by having the plane fly low over the fields at about 6 or 7 feet on a still evening and showing the fields with the spotlights. The dusting is done between 2 and 3 hours to complete and usually there is an interested audience watching the operation from the ground. The onion are grown by Ralph Causton.

Conservation Dept Warns Against Elm Destruction

Woodman — spare that (elm) tree! For a while, at least. Even though it looks sick it may not have Dutch elm disease, according to Ray Pfeifer, District Forester with Michigan Conservation Department.

Here in Southeastern Michigan people have been bombarded with advice and warnings and scare stories about the hideous Dutch elm disease. Among them have been claims on a knowledge of trees it will surely die. There are plenty of sick trees in this area — but I can assure you that they have not been noticed by their owners and as Red Steffen says, "It just don't look right to me."

"If your elm tree has healthy leaves and provides good shade now, don't worry about it. But the leaves are full of holes or spotted with any kind of discoloration or dead spots or patches — on the work of either bugs or minor disease — probably due to the wet spring we had — don't worry about that either.

Now to get down to the facts. If your elm tree suddenly withers or falls or a branch or two or all of it — it may have Dutch elm disease — or it may not. Now cut off a branch or twig — about finger size — from the affected area

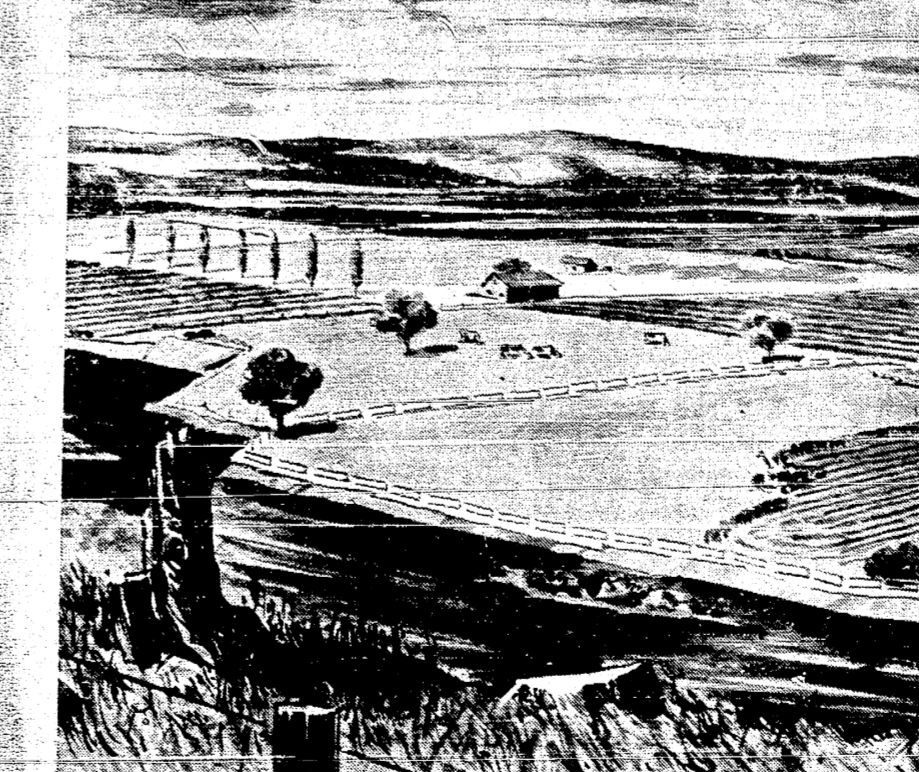

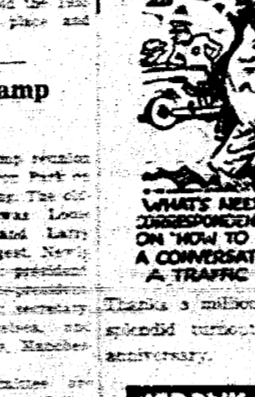

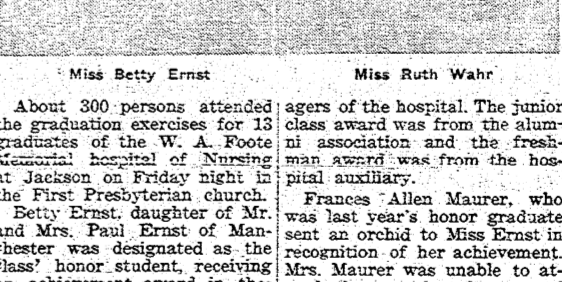
