Two Months of Flowers in Spring, All from Bulbs



For two months in the spring fall planted bulbs supply most of the color in garden borders, with the least care of any flowers, because they blossom before weeds grow, or insects prey, or drouth injures garden plants.

A flowering bulb is a package deal. It contains, like seed, an embryo piant, plus food enough to nourish it until it produces a flower. The first flower will bloom with very little help from the soil it grows in, though feeding gives a larger flower. An ending it requires extra food to develop a vigorous new bulb for the next year's flower. Summer flowering bulbs, and there which are not winer two-quart size. Drop a small spring, to be set out for another season of bloom. The precautions which are necessary to keep them in good condition are not difficult to take.

A flower which has gained widespread popularity in recent years is the tuberous rooted beyonia. When the foliage begins to decrease and turn yellow in the fall the tubers should be dug up and washed free of soil. Leave a portion of the stem for awhile, and in a week or ten days it will come loose. Do not cut or break it off. It is best to dry the tubers in the sun, or in a dry well ventilated place, for two weeks. When the last portion of the stem has fallen off or been easily removed, storage the tubers in tray, seed flats or shallow boxes one layer deep, surrounded by dry peat moss. A temperature of 45 to 50 degrees is ideal.

Do not be surprised if stored tubers develop sprouts in March or Aprill. Try not to break the sprouts and start them early in pots, keeping indoors until it is safe to carry them outside.

Gladious bulbs, dahlia tubers and canna roots snould be allowed to grow until frost kills their top growth. They will increase in size and store up food for next year's plants.


