Legislature Invites President to Move White House to Mackinac



The eyes of the world will be focused on Michigan next year if the invitation extended to President Eisenhower to bring the summer White House to Michigan in 1955 is accepted. A delegation headed by Lt. Gov. Reid and Speaker of the House Van Valkenburg have arranged through U.S. Senators Ferguson and Potter to present the invitation next month. Two Republican and one Democratic members of the State Senate and House of Representative will make the official presentation.

Since only one President in the nation's history has visited the Upper Peninsula, it is hoped that Eisenhower will accept the invitation. The world-famous Soo Locks will be 100 years old in 1825 and the president's visit would emphasize their importance to the state which has often been called the Arsenal of Democracy.






