### Record Sales of Savings Bonds Listed

The citizens of Michigan dug deep into their pockets this year and bought more U. S. savings bonds than ever before in a peacetime year and thus preserved the State's perfect record of successful bond campaigns. Noble D. Travis, State Chairman of the U. S. Savings Bonds Committee, has announced:

"Sales of Series H bonds which were introduced in 1953 rose to \$21,800,000, an increase of 120 per cent over the previous year."

"I think that the citizens of our State deserve a round of applause for their unflinching support of the Savings Bonds program year in year out, in good times and bad," Travis said.

Purchases of bonds during 1954 in Michigan amounted to \$302,792,000, surpassing the state's quota which was set at \$302,000,000. Michigan has never failed to meet its quota since the inception of the savings bonds program in 1941.

In reviewing the sales figures, Travis, who is also a member of the National Executive Committee of Savings Bonds, said: "In spite of serious economic fluctuations in the State during the past year, sales of Series E bonds amounted to \$154,000,000, the total State sales were made through payroll savings plans to employees in business and industry. The balance of the sales were to the general public in bond-a-month programs, over the counter sales at banks and the like."

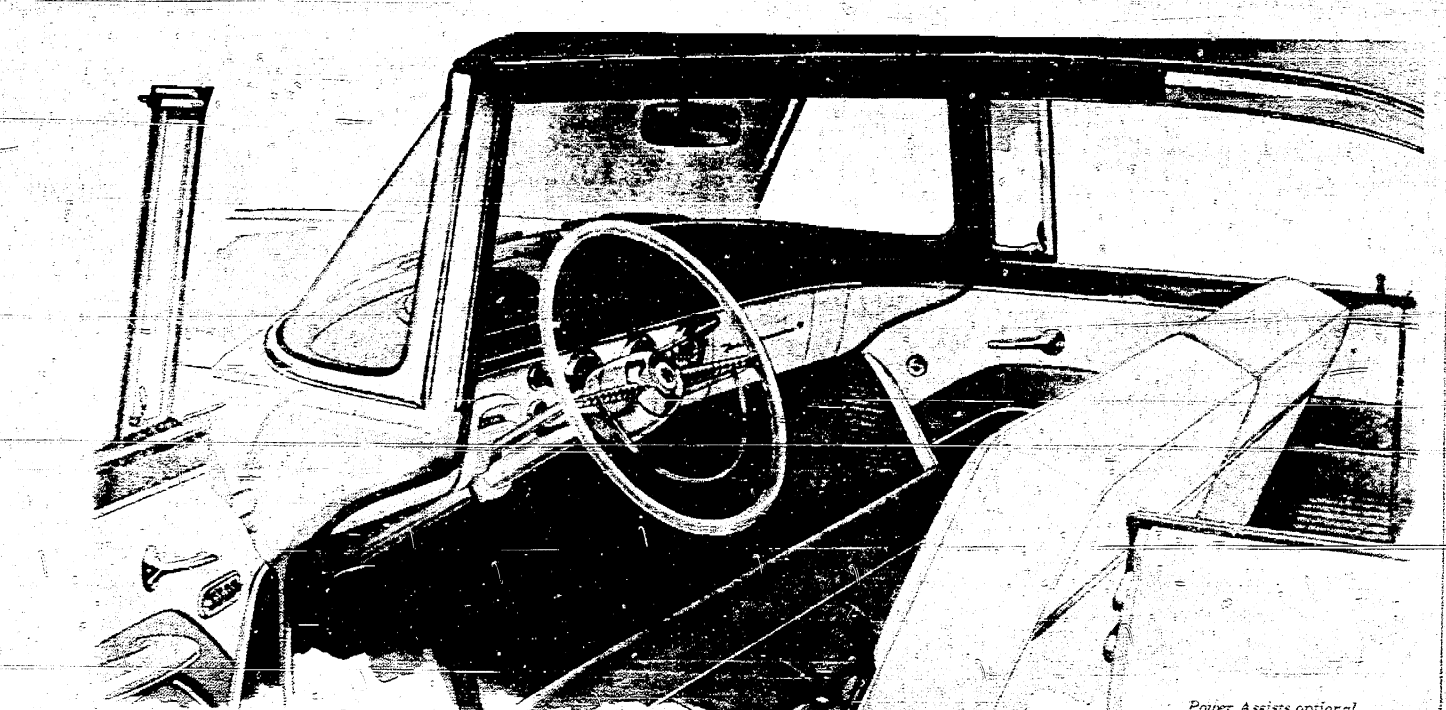

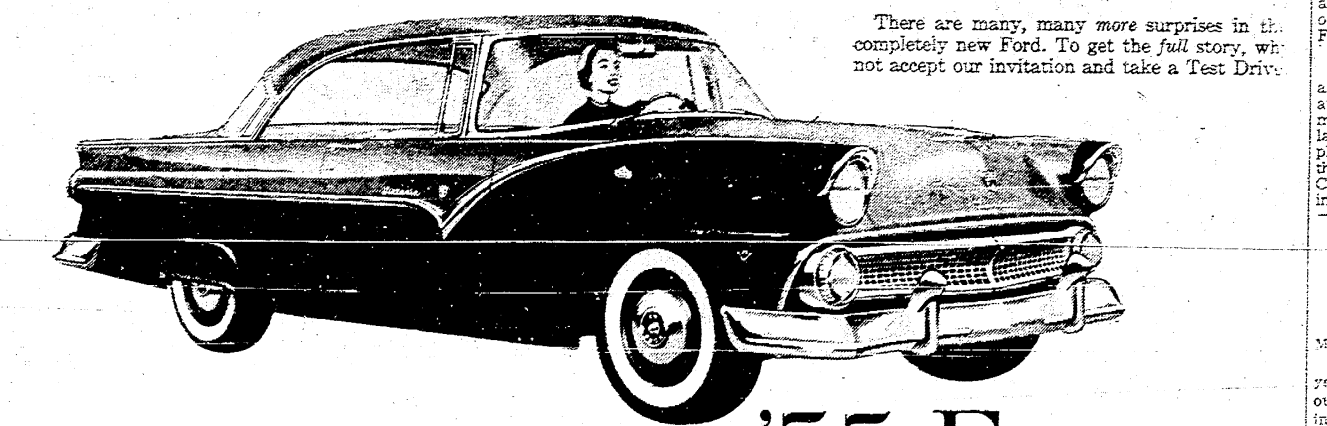
